Welcome to the 2025 – 2026 wrestling season!

Crimson Wrestling is back and we're bigger than ever! Actually, significantly bigger than ever. This season's roster includes 89 registered athletes! I would guess that's one of the biggest rosters in the state. Just over half of the roster has previous wrestling experience. This means we have roughly forty athletes who are brand new to the sport!

It's always been the goal to have a strong team on all levels including Varsity, J.V., 9th grade, and our Girls teams. Having strong numbers like this is a step in that direction. That many athletes with experience should lead to a healthy level of competition which should lead to success on the Varsity level. The depth should also result in a strong JV line-up and all those new wrestlers provides excitement at all levels including the 9th grade roster.

With about 15 girls on the roster it's also the biggest (and most talented) group of girls we've ever had. Two seasons ago we had five girls start the girls program. Three of those girls are now in their third season of wrestling and they are joined by two others with three or more years of wrestling. There is also some serious talent amongst the newest girls on the team as well. The ladies are poised to make some noise this season and it will be fun to support them in their quest!

The work ethic and passion for wrestling is evident in our practice room and that is the biggest reason to be excited going forward. Many of our wrestlers have put forth the effort to make big strides since last season and are considerably more skilled than this time last year. The opportunity for their efforts to pay off is finally here!

Every season there are wrestlers who come out of nowhere to reach levels only the people in our wrestling room believe are possible. When you have this many wrestlers giving it their all every day you know there are going to be a number of athletes that make a leap. Ultimately, every Crimson wrestler is going to grow significantly on and off the mat – and that's the most rewarding part of a new season!

There are some new additions to the coaching staff that I'm excited to expose our wrestlers to. We return nine of our twelve coaches from last season (Ron Seubert, Brad Holzerland, Carl Leuer, Daniel Polanco, Eddie Kilgard, Josh Barzowski, Jake Olmstead, Donnie Leuer, Dylan Schultz, Mason Carter, and myself) and have also added five others that will benefit the program greatly. Alumni Ireland Meade

joins the staff on the girls side this season while Carter Foch, Rufus Bartee, and Michael Mason will also be helping with the team. We are fortunate to have a strong team of coaches and mentors to help coach and lead each of our 89 Crimson wrestlers.

It's a new season and I know there are a number of Crimson wrestlers with some big individual and team goals. As a coaching staff our goal is to bring out the best in each athlete. We fully expect fans and supporters will see a consistent effort and progress that reflects the character our athletes are building through the sport of wrestling. We fully expect to have a roster that will experience the rewards that come from putting in their best effort.

As always, I look forward to seeing how each Crimson wrestler develops their talents as well as how each grows from and overcomes the adversities that come from our sport.

I'd like to take the opportunity to thank our parents, supporters, sponsors, managers, coaches, alumni and our MGSB administration for their contributions to this season. Crimson Wrestling is a Family and we appreciate all the support these athletes receive. Lastly, I'd like to applaud the athletes who put in the work and have the courage to step on the line and go to battle. Take pride in knowing your learning to do hard better and your efforts are helping you grow as an athlete as well as a person. You have chosen the more difficult path but in doing so you have also chosen to set yourself apart.
