#### **4. 8U/10U Evaluations**

##### **A. Pitching/Catching**

- Propose to have pitchers throw 10 pitches towards the target down the middle, speed, 10 pitches with a batter in the box 5 right handed batter, 5 with left handed batter. Pitchers can then throw 10 choice pitches.

(APPROVED)

- Pitchers try out on March 3 or March 5
  - Time at the end of evaluations on March 7 for catchers assessment for throws and blocking, etc. will not be scored or placed on team based on their "catcher" skills
