



## PWSA PERMISSION TO PLAY FOR 2026/2027 SEASON



*This is NOT a Player Release*

All PWSA sanctioned activities must adhere to all federal, provincial, municipal, PHU requirements and PWSA Return to Play/Tryout Protocols. The strictest requirements must be followed.

**For players registered for the 2026 season, Permission to Play forms are valid until December 31, 2026. Players without permission do not have insurance coverage.**

**No player may participate in any PWSA sanctioned activity with a team other than their own 2026 team unless they have a release or properly executed Permission to Play form.**

**Players may NOT participate in any tryout with an Affiliated or Non-Recognized program until Labour Day (September 7, 2026)**

A player who is under suspension or not in good standing is NOT eligible for Permission to Play unless they have prior written approval from the PWSA Discipline Board.

### **PWSA Player Movement / Tryout Policy.**

"Permission to Play" forms must be filled out and signed by a designated executive member of the player's current association/team and presented to the association/team for which the player wishes to try out before they are allowed on the field. Failure to comply will result in a minimum of 2 months' suspension for the offending player and/or head coach.
