Family Volunteer Commitment


- 2 shifts per family, Families who received a Scholarship need to do 3 shifts


CODE OF ETHICS & PLAYER/PARENT CONDUCT

- MYAS: Reduction in referees is an epidemic directly related to poor behavior from some parents and coaches
- Referees will ask coaches to address parent behavior if needed during a game
- FYBA expects all players, coaches and parents to represent our organization and community in a positive manner following FYBA code of ethics
- Team Liaisons will be provided (board members), and all escalations should follow the player/parent handbook



COACHING

- Candidates who indicated their interest in coaching during registration may be interviewed/contacted
 - **Note: Coaches from prior seasons might not need to go through interview process.***
- Head coaches are named after team placements – exception for teams with paid coaches
- Assistant coaches are recommended and approved
- All coaches must have an updated background check, first aid training & concussion training through Trusted Coaches
- Paid, non-parent coaches will be considered for 8th grade at A,B & C levels, 7th grade A & B, and 5th and 6th grade A (dependent on number of teams for that year)

PLAYING TIME

- Playing Time
 - 3rd / 4th / 5th – 50%
 - 6th – 45%
 - 7th – 40%
 - 8th – 35%
- Over the course of a weekend, not per game





PRACTICES

- Typically, twice a week
- Can and will include some Wednesdays and Fridays
- Typically 1.5 hours
- Practices start 1st and 2nd week in October
- Parents are discouraged from attending practices and players should not arrive at practice until 10 minutes before allotted practice time



TRYOUTS

- Dates and Times are posted on the website, FYBA Facebook, Twitter and Instagram
 - Girls: September 14-15
 - Boys: September 21-22
- Parents are encouraged to drop athletes off - no parents are allowed in the gym during tryouts.
- If you have any information that you would like the Tryout Committee to consider regarding your athlete during tryouts, it must be communicated in writing to the Player Development Director at least 48 hours prior to the start of tryouts.

TRYOUTS CONTINUED

- Items to bring to tryouts
 - Volunteer check/emergency form
 - Basketball
 - Water bottle
 - No FYBA clothing, uniforms or tournaments shirts are allowed
- Tryouts consist of drills and scrimmages
- Evaluators reach consensus on player assignments
- Team rosters will be posted by EOD 9/17 (Girls Teams) and EOD 9/24 (Boys Teams)
- Withdrawals: Parents must let Scott Duellman know by 5pm on Friday 9/16 for boys and girls in order to receive a refund (minus \$35 admin fee). All requests for withdrawal must be emailed to the below email address and must be time stamped by 5pm on the above date or the withdrawal will not be approved and NO refund will be issued.

Team Formation

- Once teams are formed and posted, coaches will reach out to the parents for a team meeting and practice schedule
- There are no objections, calling to get your player moved to another team or questioning your players spot on the team. The tryout committee does their best during the weekend to accurately place every kid so that they can have a successful season at the correct skill level
- Once teams are formed, we need to get players signed up for MYAS website to be included for the state tourney in the season. We will send out a link once these teams are formed.



UNIFORMS

- **Uniforms:**
 - Same as last season
 - Only need to order if your player is new to the travel program this season or grew out of theirs from last season
- **Ordering:**
 - Instructions will be provided after team formations are announced
 - An email will be sent out to the primary email address on your player's registration & posted on our website
 - Please make sure you order your player's uniform by the deadline - failing to do so can result in your player not having their uniform in time
- **Try-On Sessions:**
 - Will be hosted again by CA Gear
 - If you cannot attend the sessions, sizing charts will be sent out & posted on our website
- **Jersey Numbers:**
 - Players who played in the travel program last season will have their same jersey numbers
 - Those who are new to the travel program this season will have a jersey number automatically assigned to them
 - Sorry we do not take jersey number requests
