



## FYBA Board Meeting Agenda & Minutes

- Register To Play Platform
  - Currently we utilize Turney Machine as our platform for our Tiger Classic Turnneys.
  - There is a possibility of migrating to the platform that MYAS is using now called Register To Play.
  - A large number of other organizations are moving to this platform or already have.
  - Register To Play offers:
    - visibility to all of our team records along with other organization's team records.
    - allows us to be able to accept credit card payments for our Tiger Classic registration fees via Stripe, we would just need to create an account. Currently  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the tourneys we register our teams for are paid via credit card.
    - when teams register and pay via credit card they will automatically be registered, we will not have to do this manually.
    - you can set a number limit for teams allowed per bracket and when the limit is reached it will start a waiting list for you.
    - Puts QR code on each scoresheet so the board member entering the scores can just scan the QR code and it will take them directly to that game to enter the score.
  - Might have to increase the registration fee to offset the cost of the new platform.
  - Creating brackets might be more manually and labor intensive but doable.
    - Register To Play does plug in times and courts, but we would need to place the teams where Turney Machine did this step automatically for us.
  - The recommendation from Pete is that it would be in the board's best interest to move to the Register to Play platform.
  - Final decision will be made this month.

- FYBA has been presented with the opportunity to possibly implement pull tabs.
- We would be required to obtain a license from the state and we would need to secure a gambling manager to handle the operation and the audits. The gambling manager would be paid.
- The cost to implement this would be estimated at \$600 the first year and then \$300 a year after that.
- The city of Farmington would need to sign off on this.
- DeGraff will research this more and speak to the establishment to understand if there are any restrictions and other important information.
- Coaches

  - 2 hour windows to be set up for 2 nights to speak with coaches on their philosophy, see if they fit into FYBA for those interested in being a paid coach.
  - Scott Johnson will reach out to candidates to confirm their availability.
- Open Gym

  - Players will be able to work on their own or participate in skill based drills.
  - Annie is going to confirm with Cheryl what the cost for the gym space will be.
  - Once we know the cost we can discuss further on the frequency and what night these will be held on.
