1. Brian Ammann – MSB: have been working with Farmington for 15 years, prices have stayed the same. Introduce fundamentals and how to shoot the basketball. Be a resource for athletes as they mature through their basketball career. Will always offer a free coaches clinic, 60-65 minutes, will help the process throughout the season. Want coaches there for skills nights. *Q: what are we working on for 6<sup>th</sup> grade and older, after they've been working on fundamentals 3-5<sup>th</sup> grade. A: will add in some more foot work, but still won't add in spin moves/behind the back, fancy moves. Fundamentals take years and focusing on shooting form is essential.* Basic shooting mechanics is core, then it's all just additional footwork. Will only resonate with repetition. The kids that are good can fight through the boredom and repetition. *Q: when do you need commitments? A: by the end of this month. Currently advertising out to the end of September. Rosemount is bringing 7-8<sup>th</sup> graders in on Saturdays 9-12 to rework basic shooting & foot work.*
