- Approved March 3 Board Meeting minutes – posted to SYBA website
- Reviewed Financials
 - Paid Travel and Community League Jerseys and hats
 - School charged for Field House use for tryouts and field prep/clean-up
 - Pushing back as why SYBA was charged when these were not fundraising activities
 - Voted to pay for Biff at Westminster 1 for the season
- Board agreed to compensate Non-Parent Coaches at 12A, 12AA and Community League levels and In-house levels
 - 12A and 12AA Travel coaches will receive \$800
 - Amount for the Community League coach will be determined at the end of the year
 - The compensation will come from Tournament proceeds
 - Board also discussed possible discounts for Mites coaches if needed
- The Board reviewed our refund policy
 - Decided to keep the refund policy as is, but call out injuries
 - Decided to address injuries on a case by case basis
 - Will post policy on website so it is easily found
- SYBA Tournament Roles were discussed
 - Agreed to offer DIBS for chalking and mound set-up on Friday prior to tournament start. Hours are 8am to 2pm.
 - Allen will send out draft of schedule for Board members for the weekend
 - Discussed potential for concessions at Tahpah 5-8 and Westminster 1. Logistics TBD.

- Rod Hicks gave an update on Little League registration - currently at 49 players
 - Board decided to have 5 teams of 9-10 players to allow for kids to be more involved in the game.
 - The team on a "bye" will have practice at the 17th Ave Cages
- In-house Update
 - Evaluations on May 4 will need help from Board Members and potential coaches
 - 13's and 14's will be asked to help catch Little League pitching evaluations
 - Mites and Little League coaches meeting will be May 8th at West Shed
 - Need to ensure Red Oak is mowed in the summer - email to Sherry
- Storage needs for Fields
 - Tom is looking into whether the 2 sheds at the high school can be used at Green Meadow and Tahpah West
 - Need Bill Egan (City) to approve
 - May purchase from high school class
 - Board voted to purchase 2 Knaack boxes
 - 1 for Tahpah 8
 - 1 for Green Meadow until city approves a shed there
- Tahpah West status
 - HS Community Coach notified SYBA Fields that field was padlocked with no bases or benches - Eric emailed Sherry and Bill for update
- Dave Johnson informed Board that a couple of other Shakopee Associations (including Football) are discussing putting money towards a Dome in the City
 - Board discussed possibility of contributing to the Dome
 - More info is needed
- Board discussed Fall Tryouts for 11u-14u
 - 9u and 10u will remain in Spring
 - 14's not making AAA and AA will go through joint evaluations/tryout with 15's not AAA/AA to create 14/15A team
 - Board decided to have members gather information from other associations that have fall tryouts (and associations that have spring tryouts) to bring to next meeting
 - Board agreed to vote on Fall Tryouts at next meeting
- Board discussed alternate pants color, if whole team agrees
 - Voted to amend policy to: Keep primary pant uniform color light grey, but allow teams to have option to wear white pants as alternate pants, if the ENTIRE team votes to do so
- City informed Board that slats cannot be added to Green Meadow outfield fence due to City Ordinance
- Board member witnessed players hitting baseballs into fence, which can damage fences (i.e. backstop)
 - An email will be sent to the Association to remind players/coaches to not hit baseballs into the fences.
- Board approved purchasing new catchers mitts for In-house/Community Leagues
- Next meeting date will be 6:30pm on Sunday May 19 at Shakopee Bowl
