- **Approve Previous Meeting Minutes**

- **Financial Review**

Rob Deuth reviewed the latest statement from 4/1/25 – 4/30/25

Total inflow for this time period include: \$15,812.94 in player registrations and the SYBA Credit Card payment of \$1,052.

Total Inflows were: \$16,865.18.

Outflows for this time period include: \$80 to Innovative Graphics, \$1,662.45 to Doehling Landscape for Jackson Field. \$125 in the monthly fee for the Sportsengine website, \$450 in a tournament refund. Registration refunds totaling \$1,676.55. Payments made to The Shed in the amounts of \$5,875 and \$9,075. \$17.05 to Shakopee Public Utilities for Jackson Field.

\$1,968.75 for Gold Cards, \$95 for a Health Permit for the Shakopee Tournament, and \$1,052.64 in payment to the SYBA Credit Card.

Total Outflows for Checking were: \$22,0081.44

Credit Card: total \$3,680.65 for gym rental from Shakopee Public

Total Total Outflows \$25,762.09

Checking Ending Balance at the end of this statement: \$58,304.29

The Savings Account had \$0.99 in interest for the time frame. The Savings Account ending balance for this time frame is: \$60,038.87

There is a Sponsorship Fund that was set up and approved from previous meetings, Rob reviewed the different aspects of what will go into this fund, as well as provided an update on where the new SnapRaise fundraising is projected to land. It is projected that SnapRaise will end up raising close to \$25,000.

The Omaha Account has \$16,859.71 at the end of this statement.

- **Legion Financial Review**

Total inflows for this period was: \$4,800.98, these include: \$150.98 in pulltab donations, \$650 in a player registration, and \$4,000 in donations received.

Total Outflows for this period was: \$1,500, from stadium expenses, these expenses are for diamond dry, paint, and aglime.

Total Checking Account at the end of the \$39,515.42
