The President provides the heart and vision for the association, ensuring we stay focused on our mission to provide a great experience for every player. This role involves leading our board and member meetings with a collaborative spirit and making sure all our collective goals are put into action. As the primary link between our association, the arena, and the district, the President builds the relationships that keep our program strong. They personally help resolve member concerns, serve as a vital member of the disciplinary committee, and lead the pre-season orientation to welcome our families back to the rink. This role oversees the following position: Safe Sport Coordinator.

Vice President

The Vice President stands ready to support the President and the board in any way needed to keep our operations running smoothly. A major focus of this role is championing player growth by leading the Hockey Development Committee, ensuring our athletes have the best coaching and skill-building opportunities available. They represent our local interests at district meetings and help maintain a fair, positive environment for everyone by serving on the disciplinary committee. This role oversees the following positions: Mite/8U Coordinator and Ice Time Coordinator.

Treasurer

The Treasurer acts as the careful steward of our association's resources, ensuring that every dollar is managed transparently to benefit our families and players. They handle the essential behind-the-scenes work, from managing our mail and bookkeeping to filing the necessary paperwork that keeps us healthy as a non-profit. This role oversees the following positions: Equipment Coordinator, Outdoor Rink Coordinator, and Tournament Coordinator.

Communications Director

The Communications Director tells the story of our association, using the website and social media to celebrate our players' achievements and keep families connected. They ensure our digital home is a helpful resource for everyone and use member surveys to make sure every family has a voice in how we improve. This role helps protect the integrity of our program by investigating grievances and serving on the disciplinary committee, while also coordinating team photos and championship banners to honor our players' hard work. This role oversees the following positions: Sponsorship Coordinator and Clothing & Apparel Coordinator.

Manager Director

The Manager Director serves as a dedicated mentor and resource for our Team Managers, ensuring they have the training and handbooks they need to lead their individual teams successfully. By empowering our managers, this role helps ensure that every team in the association has an organized and positive season. This role oversees the following positions: Team Managers.

Board Member at Large

The Board Member at Large brings a vital community perspective to the table, representing the interests of New Prague area families in every board discussion. They play a key role in maintaining a fair environment for our members by serving on the disciplinary committee and investigating grievances with care and objectivity. This role oversees the following position: Retention and Recruitment Coordinator.

Past Board Member

especially valuable as they serve on the disciplinary committee, offering a steady and seasoned perspective to help resolve issues and keep the association moving forward.

HDC Lead The HDC Lead is dedicated to the growth of our players and coaches on the boys' side of the association. This role guides the Hockey Development Committee in selecting head coaches, creating player development paths, and overseeing the annual tryout and placement process for all levels, including Mites. Unlike most board positions, the Lead is recommended by the HDC members and appointed by the Board, ensuring the role is filled by someone with deep hockey expertise. They lead a committee of volunteers and coaches to ensure our boys' hockey program remains competitive and rewarding.

Girls HDC Lead The Girls HDC Lead focuses specifically on the development and success of our female athletes from the 8U through 12U levels. They lead the Girls Hockey Development Committee in managing coach selection, player education, and the tryout process, providing oversight for the 8U program. Recommended by the HDC and appointed by the Board, this leader ensures our girls' program has a strong, dedicated voice. They work collaboratively with the boys' HDC through the 2025-2026 season before transitioning to independent operation to further grow the girls' game.

Gambling Manager The Gambling Manager plays a vital role in our association's financial health by overseeing our charitable gambling efforts. They serve as the expert on state rules and regulations, maintaining strong relationships with our hosting establishments and ensuring all reporting is transparent and timely. By leading a dedicated committee and managing our gambling funds with care, they help provide the resources that keep our hockey programs thriving.

Concession Stand Coordinator The Concession Stand Coordinator ensures our concession stand is a welcoming and well-stocked hub for our fans and families. This role leads a team of up to eight managers who handle daily operations, from scheduling and stocking to maintaining a clean environment. By providing high-level oversight of finances and recommending equipment upgrades, the Coordinator ensures the stand remains a successful and efficient asset for the association.

Volunteer Coordinator The Volunteer Coordinator is the heart of our community participation, managing the Dibs program to ensure every family has the opportunity to get involved. By partnering with various coordinators to post and track volunteer hours, they keep our members informed and aligned.
