The following Financial Disclosure and Program Information is hereby provided pursuant to the "Tier II Program Disclosure Requirements" as set forth in the TAHA Guidebook/Rulebook and must be finalized seven (7) days prior to the commencement of 2026-2027 season tryouts.

### FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE

#### Player Registration Fees

(1) The amount to be paid to the organization for making the team, which generally covers the cost of ice, coach salary, league fees, on-ice officials, and off-ice trainings. Generally, this amount shall reflect all monies that would be collected at contract signing.

#### Required Apparel

For example, these items may include, but are not limited to, jerseys, breezers, breezer shells, socks, helmets, gloves, bags, warmups, workout clothes or items, and any other item required to be purchased through the organization or its designated vendor. The full amount to be paid by a new player to the organization must be disclosed, but an organization may note if the cost will be lower for returning players who may use gear from prior years.

**Team Fees

This amount shall also include any team fees not required to be paid by the organization, but that are made mandatory by a majority vote of the team members or their families.

Team Fees are intended to cover costs including, but not limited to: non-parent coach travel, tournament entry fees and officials outside of THL/Tier II State games, additional ice purchases (if any), team events, meals, and team building, and miscellaneous team expenses. It should be noted that the within costs may be significantly reduced by donations and team fundraising efforts as well as 'complimentary' non-parent coach hotel rooms. Any 'cash call' amounts collected but not spent by the team will be refunded at the end of the season.

## PROGRAM INFORMATION

**Estimated Full-Ice Equivalent Hours**

(1) Describe the amount of ice practices that the team will receive from the organization. This can be described as the minimum hours of on-ice practices the team will receive during the season or by providing the minimum number of practices the team will receive along with the length of such practices. Only the minimum amount of ice to be provided may be included. Organizations may not include language in their disclosure that the team may or will receive additional ice in addition to the stated minimum amount and shall not make such statements orally. Organizations may include in this disclosure ice that is used by a team for scrimmages or similar events so long as the team is not required to pay additional amounts to the organization or rink to purchase the ice. Ice used for league games and tournament games shall not be included in this amount.

**Additional Info**

Practices may be held at Bellerive Ice Center, Ice Skate Memorial City, Deep South Ice and Sports Center, Sugar Land Ice, and the Aerodrome Ice Skating Complex. Teams may expect weekend and weeknight practices to be held at any one of said facilities throughout the season. Weeknight practices are generally held T/W/Th.

Practice schedule will begin mid-August. A schedule in regards to times/rinks will be made available at that time with a supplemental practice schedule to be released (mid-late September) upon finalizing the league game schedule. Every reasonable effort will be made to provide regular and semi-predictable practice times and locations.

The organization provides an accounting of ice usage to each team at the end of the season. Should any portion of the team's ice budget not be used, the organization shall refund to the team the value of the unused ice (at market price). Such refund shall be treated as a pro-rata refund of player registration fees paid in full. Should the team use more than its budgeted ice, the team shall be invoiced for such ice (at market price).

**Weekly Off-ice Training Sessions**

(2) Details regarding the amount and frequency of off-ice training a team will receive. This should generally be described as follows: two 1-hour sessions per week or similar language. If the vendor providing such training is known, that information must be disclosed. If training will occur at a site other than the organization's home rink, the location should be disclosed.
