

Filling out Scoresheets properly:

1. Age Level – team type such as 8U Mite, 10U Squirt, etc.
2. Date – date of the game. Ex. 9/12/2021
3. Rink – where the game is being played. Ex: WOI-NEW
4. Home & Visiting Teams – Print your CHC Association name (if not on labels) here, along with the type of team, AA, A, A!, B Blue, etc. Do not print nicknames like Islanders or Bruins on labels.
5. Players' Full name and number. NO nicknames. Use stickers, but you must remember to CROSS OFF on ALL label copies the names of the players not in uniform/participating in that game. You will need 4 stickers for each game and more for Tournaments. If your opponent does not have stickers, have their managers fill in this section.
6. Coaches Info – if not on labels- coaches' names, their USA Hockey Coaching Education Program (CEP) card number, CEP level 1,2,3,4 or 5, and the expiration date. All coaches must be certified by Dec. 31, 2023, and Oct 31, 2023, for split-season teams. See your official USAH roster for Coaches' information. NOTE: If the coach is not on the roster and cannot be on the bench!
7. Home & Visitor Verification – One coach from each team MUST sign the score sheet at the end of the game. Once signed, no changes can be made.
8. Scoring – only enter goals and assists, as the REFEREES call them (Not by Coaches or parents) – Remember to enter and circle the total score for each team at the end of the game.
9. Saves – enter the goalies' number and track all saves (not shots). Repeat the same process on the second line if the game is split between two goalies.
10. Penalties – enter penalties called by the referees. The type/minutes needed to serve- starting and ending time off the clock— each penalty must be entered on a separate line. EX A player gets both a fighting and game miscounts- 2 different lines not together with times severe for each. Review the Game Period and penalty duration sheet for each age level.
11. This area is for the referees to print and sign their names. If possible, please have all referees print their state numbers next to their names. Make sure you can read the Ref name.
12. Make a note at the bottom of the sheet or on all the game labels of any players/coaches who sit out/leave a game due to a violation or suspension.
