MIKE IS A NATIVE OF VANCOUVER, CANADA, AND BRINGS EXTENSIVE EXPERIENCE FROM BOTH HIS PROFESSIONAL PLAYING AND COACHING CAREERS. HE PLAYED FIVE SEASONS IN THE WESTERN HOCKEY LEAGUE (WHL), WHERE HE SERVED AS TEAM CAPTAIN AND EARNED RECOGNITION AS AN ALL-STAR DEFENSEMAN. FOLLOWING HIS JUNIOR CAREER, MIKE SIGNED A THREE-YEAR ENTRY-LEVEL CONTRACT IN THE NHL, SPENDING TIME WITHIN THE ORGANIZATIONS OF THE NEW YORK RANGERS AND THE MONTREAL CANADIENS.

OVER THE COURSE OF A 10-YEAR PROFESSIONAL PLAYING CAREER, MIKE COMPETED ACROSS NORTH AMERICA AND EUROPE, INCLUDING TWO SEASONS WITH THE CHARLOTTE CHECKERS. AFTER RETIRING FROM PROFESSIONAL PLAY, HE TRANSITIONED INTO COACHING, BEGINNING WITH TWO SEASONS COACHING PROFESSIONALLY IN ASIA BEFORE RETURNING TO WESTERN CANADA TO COACH AT A HOCKEY ACADEMY.

MIKE BRINGS A WEALTH OF KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERIENCE AS BOTH A PLAYER AND COACH, WHICH CONTINUES TO BENEFIT THE PROGRAM AT EVERY LEVEL. HE IS ALSO THE CO-FOUNDER AND HEAD ON-ICE INSTRUCTOR OF THE SOUTHERN PROSPECTS HOCKEY ACADEMY. THIS UPCOMING SEASON WILL MARK MIKE'S FIFTH YEAR WITH THE ROYALS.

8U DEVELOPMENT

OUR "INTRO TO TRAVEL", ALLOWING OUR 8U PLAYERS A SMALLER SCALE TRAVEL SEASON. THROUGH WEEKLY DEVELOPMENT SESSIONS, OUR 8U PLAYERS WILL WORK HARD TO DEVELOP PROPER FUNDAMENTALS AND SKILLS, ALL WHILE CREATING MEMORIES WITH THEIR TEAMMATES.

10U & 12U

THE USA HOCKEY "LEARN TO TRAIN" PHASE TAKES PLACE DURING THE AGES OF 10-12. THESE AGE LEVELS ARE PRIME OPPORTUNITIES FOR PLAYERS TO DEVELOP FINE MOTOR SKILLS AND THE RIGHT WAY TO TRAIN. USA HOCKEY EXPLAINS THAT WHAT IS LEARNED DURING THIS TIME PLAYS A MAJOR ROLE IN THE REST OF THE ATHLETES CAREER. EMPHASIZING THE IMPORTANCE OF PLAYING AT THE APPROPRIATE LEVEL REGARDLESS OF LETTER (A/AA/AAA).

REFERENCED AS USA HOCKEY'S "TRAIN TO TRAIN" PHASE. TIER 1 TRYOUTS (AAA) - APRIL 3RD & 4TH

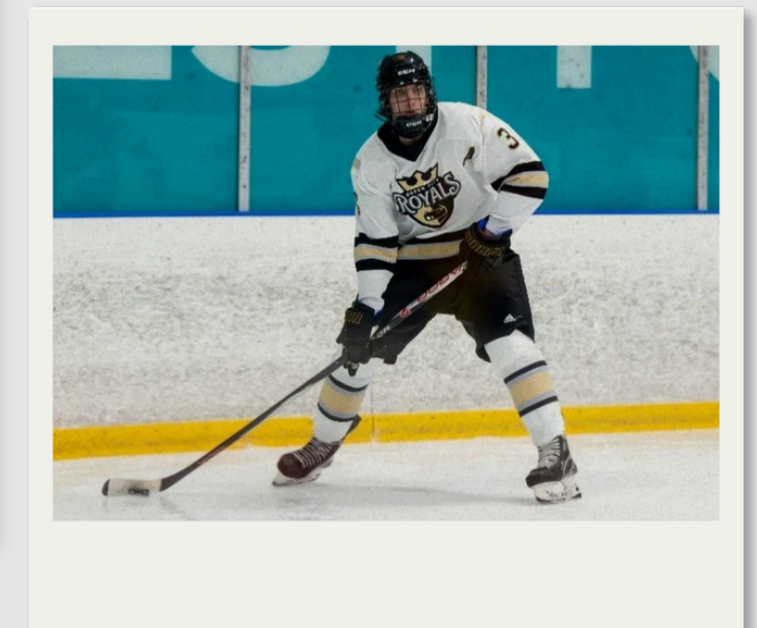
TIER 1 TRYOUTS ARE OPEN TO ALL YOUTH HOCKEY PLAYERS BETWEEN THE 2008 TO 2015 BIRTH YEARS. THESE PLAYERS ARE LOOKING FOR THE MOST COMPETITIVE HOCKEY EXPERIENCE.

TIER 2 TRYOUTS - AA (MAY 1ST & 2ND), A (MAY 9TH & 10TH)

TIER 2 TRYOUTS ARE OPEN TO ALL PLAYERS BETWEEN THE 2008 TO 2017 BIRTH YEARS. THESE PLAYERS ARE LOOKING FOR A COMPETITIVE HOCKEY EXPERIENCE WITH A LESSER TRAVEL REQUIREMENT THAN TIER 1.

GIRLS TRYOUTS - MAY 1ST & 2ND

THE GIRLS TRYOUTS WILL BE OPEN TO ALL GIRLS BETWEEN THE 2010 TO 2017 BIRTH YEARS. THESE PLAYERS ARE LOOKING FOR THE MOST COMPETITIVE HOCKEY EXPERIENCE IN THE SOUTHEAST.



WHAT IS TIER 1 & TIER 2?

TIER 1 (AAA)

REPRESENTS THE HIGHEST LEVEL OF COMPETITIVE YOUTH TRAVEL HOCKEY. PLAYERS AT THIS LEVEL TYPICALLY DEMONSTRATE EXCEPTIONAL SKILLS AND COMMITMENT TO THE SPORT WITH ASPIRATIONS OF PLAYING AT HIGHER LEVELS.



TIER 2 (AA)

INCLUDES BOTH AA AND A LEVELS WITH AA BEING THE HIGHER OF THE TWO. PLAYERS IN TIER 2 HOCKEY ARE STILL HIGHLY SKILLED AND COMMITTED, BUT ARE CONTINUING TO DEVELOP THEIR HOCKEY SKILLS IN ORDER TO PROGRESS TO THE NEXT LEVEL.

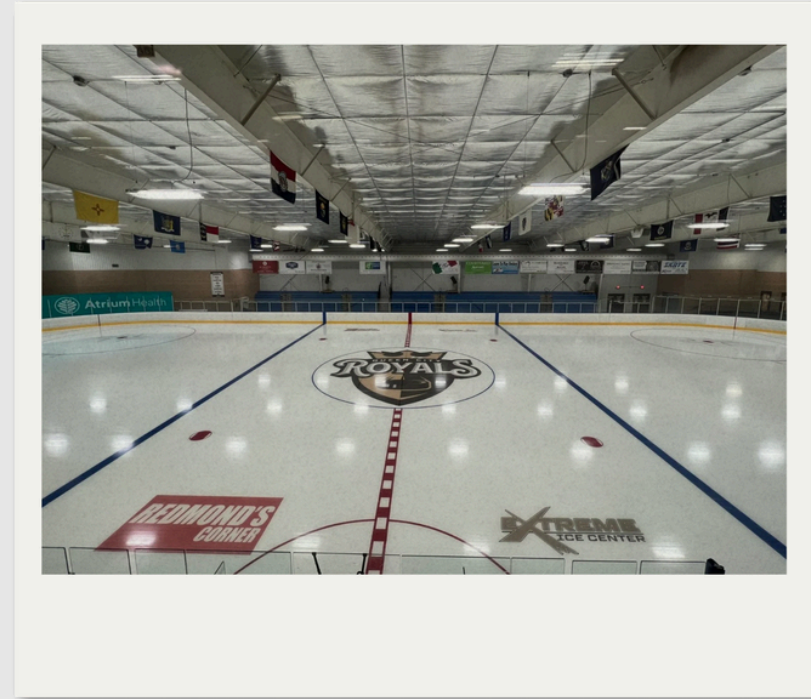


COMMITMENT TO EXCELLENCE

OUR COACHING STAFF BRINGS EXTENSIVE EXPERIENCE FROM ELITE LEVELS OF BOTH PLAYING AND COACHING. MEMBERS OF OUR STAFF HAVE COMPETED IN OR COACHED WITHIN TOP DEVELOPMENT AND PROFESSIONAL LEAGUES INCLUDING THE UNITED STATES HOCKEY LEAGUE (USHL), UNITED STATES PREMIER HOCKEY LEAGUE (USPHL), NORTH AMERICAN HOCKEY LEAGUE (NAHL), NATIONAL COLLEGIATE DEVELOPMENT CONFERENCE (NCDC), WESTERN HOCKEY LEAGUE (WHL), NCAA DIVISION III, SOUTHERN PROFESSIONAL HOCKEY LEAGUE (SPHL), ECHL, AMERICAN HOCKEY LEAGUE (AHL), AND THE NATIONAL HOCKEY LEAGUE (NHL), AS WELL AS PROFESSIONAL LEAGUES THROUGHOUT EUROPE AND ASIA. OUR PROGRAM ALSO MAINTAINS ONE OF THE HIGHEST PERCENTAGES OF NON-PARENT HEAD COACHES WITHIN THE CAROLINA AMATEUR HOCKEY ASSOCIATION (CAHA) AFFILIATE STRUCTURE, REINFORCING OUR COMMITMENT TO EXPERIENCED, INDEPENDENT LEADERSHIP BEHIND THE BENCH.

OUR TEAMS TRAIN AND COMPETE AT THE EXTREME ICE CENTER AND THE PINEVILLE ICE HOUSE, TWO WIDELY REGARDED PREMIER HOCKEY FACILITIES IN NORTH AMERICA. OUR FACILITIES PROVIDE A PROFESSIONAL TRAINING ENVIRONMENT, AND WE CONTINUE TO INVEST IN TOP-OF-THE-LINE EQUIPMENT AND RESOURCES TO ENHANCE THE PLAYER EXPERIENCE WHILE SUPPORTING OPTIMAL DEVELOPMENT AND PERFORMANCE.

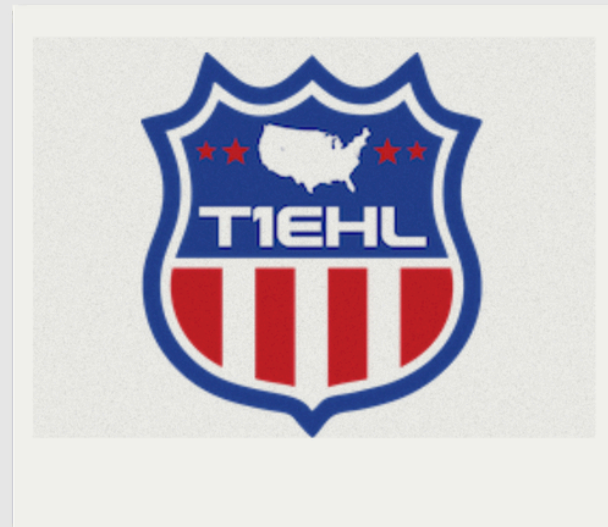
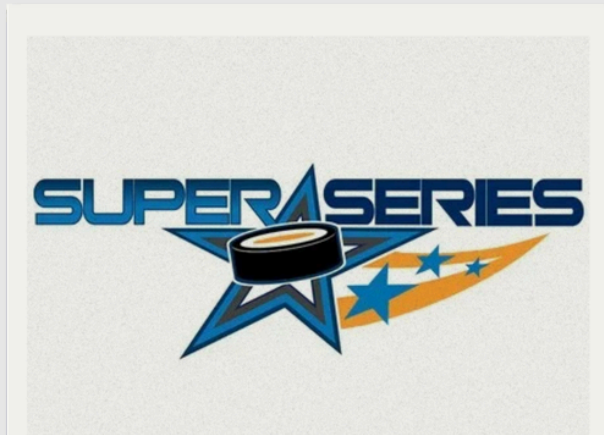

TIER 1 LEAGUES



OUR AAA TEAMS WILL PARTICIPATE IN A NUMBER OF HIGH-LEVEL EVENTS THROUGHOUT THE SEASON DESIGNED TO PROVIDE CONSISTENT COMPETITION, EXPOSURE, AND DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR OUR PLAYERS.

THE PROGRAM WILL CONTINUE TO PARTICIPATE AS A GUEST MEMBER IN THE TIER 1 HOCKEY FEDERATION (THF). THE THF PROVIDES A STRUCTURED SCHEDULE OF HIGHLY COMPETITIVE GAMES AGAINST STRONG PROGRAMS FROM ACROSS THE REGION, OFFERING OUR OLDER TEAMS REGULAR OPPORTUNITIES TO COMPETE AT A HIGH LEVEL THROUGHOUT THE SEASON. PARTICIPATING IN THE EVENTS ALLOWS OUR PLAYERS TO FACE TOP-TIER COMPETITION WHILE GAINING VALUABLE GAME EXPERIENCE IN A LEAGUE-STYLE ENVIRONMENT.

IN ADDITION TO THE THF COMPETITION, OUR TEAMS WILL ATTEND SEVERAL PREMIER TOURNAMENTS HOSTED BY ORGANIZATIONS SUCH AS SUPER SERIES AAA, CCM HOCKEY, AND TIEHL. THESE EVENTS BRING TOGETHER ELITE TEAMS FROM ACROSS THE COUNTRY AND PROVIDE PLAYERS WITH THE OPPORTUNITY TO COMPETE IN WELL-ORGANIZED, HIGH-VISIBILITY TOURNAMENTS THAT EMPHASIZE STRONG COMPETITION AND PLAYER DEVELOPMENT.

WE ARE ALSO ACTIVELY EXPLORING OPPORTUNITIES TO PARTICIPATE IN EVENTS HOSTED BY THE NORTH AMERICAN TIER 1 HOCKEY LEAGUE (NATIHL). THESE EVENTS FEATURE STRONG TIER 1 AND AAA PROGRAMS AND WOULD FURTHER ENHANCE THE COMPETITIVE SCHEDULE FOR OUR TEAMS WHILE OFFERING ADDITIONAL EXPOSURE AND DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES THROUGHOUT THE SEASON.

BY COMBINING LEAGUE PLAY WITH HIGH-QUALITY TOURNAMENTS AND SHOWCASE-STYLE EVENTS, OUR GOAL IS TO CREATE A BALANCED AND CHALLENGING SCHEDULE THAT SUPPORTS BOTH TEAM SUCCESS AND INDIVIDUAL PLAYER GROWTH OVER THE COURSE OF THE SEASON.

COACHING BIOGRAPHIES - 11UAAA & 12UAAA

CASEY HAINES (11UAAA)

OUR 11U AAA TEAM WILL BE LED BY HEAD COACH CASEY HAINES, WHOSE EXTENSIVE PLAYING AND COACHING BACKGROUND BRINGS ELITE EXPERIENCE AND LEADERSHIP TO THE PROGRAM. CASEY PLAYED THREE SEASONS IN THE NAHL AND FOUR YEARS OF NCAA DIVISION I HOCKEY AT FERRIS STATE UNIVERSITY, FOLLOWED BY OVER 150 PROFESSIONAL GAMES IN THE ECHL, EIHL, AND THE AHL. HE HAS SPENT THE PAST FIVE SEASONS COACHING WITHIN OUR PROGRAM AND MOST RECENTLY LED OUR TOP-RANKED 10U TEAM IN THE STATE TO AN ACHC LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP.

BRENDAN LOGAN (11UAAA)

BRENDAN PLAYED JUNIOR HOCKEY ACROSS MULTIPLE LEAGUES BEFORE COMPETING FOR THREE YEARS IN NCAA DIVISION III HOCKEY AT AURORA UNIVERSITY AND WILKES UNIVERSITY. AFTER A SHORT STINT IN MINOR PROFESSIONAL HOCKEY, BRENDAN FOUNDED THE QUEEN CITY ROYALS AND HAS SINCE COACHED NUMEROUS TEAMS AND AGE LEVELS WITHIN THE ORGANIZATION.

GRANT GALLO (12UAAA)

GRANT GALLO BRINGS NCAA DIVISION III PLAYING EXPERIENCE FROM NAZARETH UNIVERSITY AND A PROVEN TRACK RECORD OF PLAYER DEVELOPMENT. HE PREVIOUSLY LED THE 12UAA AND 16UAA PROGRAMS IN COLORADO AND MOST RECENTLY SERVED AS THE 12UAA HEAD COACH AND THE 18UAAA ASSISTANT COACH WITHIN THE ROYALS ORGANIZATION. GRANT'S COMPETITIVE BACKGROUND AND DEVELOPMENT-FOCUSED APPROACH MAKE HIM A STRONG LEADER FOR OUR 12UAAA GROUP.

WE ARE EXCITED ABOUT THE LEADERSHIP, EXPERIENCE, AND ENERGY THIS STAFF BRINGS TO OUR 12UAAA PROGRAM.



COACHING BIOGRAPHIES - 13UAAA & 14UAAA

BRENTON BLASKIE (13UAAA AND 14UAAA)

BRENTON BLASKIE JOINS THE STAFF WITH EXPERIENCE ACROSS ALL LEVELS OF YOUTH AND HIGH SCHOOL HOCKEY. HE COACHED IN THE OHIO AAA BLUE JACKETS PROGRAM FROM 2012-2024, WORKING WITH TEAMS FROM 10U THROUGH 18U. HE HAS BEEN HEAVILY INVOLVED IN THE COLUMBUS HOCKEY COMMUNITY, INCLUDING HELPING DESIGN THE COLUMBUS BLUE JACKETS HOCKEY LEAGUE. HE SERVED AS THE LEAD DEVELOPMENT COACH FOR THREE YEARS, BUILDING AND IMPLEMENTING PRACTICE PLANS AND PLAYER/COACH DEVELOPMENT SYSTEMS.

BLASKIE ALSO BRINGS EIGHT YEARS OF VARSITY COACHING EXPERIENCE. THIS PAST SEASON, HE COACHED WITH CAROLINA PREMIER HOCKEY AT THE 13UAAA AND 12U SELECTS LEVEL.

HE CURRENTLY SERVES AS EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE MATTHEWS ATHLETIC AND RECREATION ASSOCIATION.

JOEY STRADA (14UAAA AND 13UAAA)

JOEY STRADA IS A FORMER JUNIOR AND PROFESSIONAL FORWARD WITH A STRONG COMPETITIVE BACKGROUND.
