Objective

This policy serves to describe the Oshkosh Area Youth Hockey Association (“OAYHA”) Scrip Policy.

Storage

Editable document formats of this policy shall be stored in an easily identified and secure directory within the approved Google Drive. Access

1. Revisions shall be accessible to all Directors and Officers for the purpose of historical tracking and future versions.

Definitions

Policy

Scrip is a fundraising program that the OAYHA offers. Scrip is simply a rebate program that helps the OAYHA fundraise and earn rebates our families can use in various ways. Scrip is an annual program that begins June 1st of one calendar year and runs through May 31st of the following calendar year. The Scrip rebates will be applied to the season that starts following the end of the Scrip year.

The parties agree as follows:

1. Rebates earned will be used in the following ways:

- a. 20% of what you earn will be retained by the OAYHA as a component to group fundraising efforts
- b. 80% of what you earn will be allocated as follows: (please check one)

2. Please do the following with balances in excess of my designated skater's season/registration fees

Your Scrip rebates will be applied as directed above at the opening of registration each year. With respect to any charitable contributions you selected OAYHA will provide you with the required acknowledgements under sections 170(f)(8) and 170(f)(17) of the Internal Revenue Code.

You agree to indemnify OAYHA against any loss incurred in connection with there being insufficient funds in your account to cover the checks or ACH

Please sign and date below to indicate your acknowledgement of this agreement. This agreement must be renewed annually prior to your participation. All funds earned in the last year of participation prior to entering the Ice Hawk or other high school program will be distributed to that eligible organization pending their acceptance of these funds & in the form of a check. This accepting high school hockey organization reserves the right to apply these to individual fees or to the group as a whole in accordance with their governing rules and regulations, which may differ from that of OAYHA.

Scrip FAQs

1. **Can I use these cards to pay off my store credit card balance?** This info is most current through RaiseRight and retailers details online.

2. **Do SCRIP cards/certificates expire?** Every card is different. Find specific terms by looking at "Retailers" link on Great Lakes Scrip Center website www.glscrip.com.

3. **What happens to unused SCRIP balances?** Balances are not carried year to year. See page 1 of the Scrip agreement.

4. **Can family & friends purchase SCRIP to reduce our skater's fees?** Yes, they can but we would prefer they purchase through you. Since orders and pick-ups are done at the ice rink, we think it would be easier for you to include their orders in with yours. If they want to handle their own orders then they would have to complete a SCRIP application form and handle their own drop & pick up of orders. Remind them that many gift cards are available electronically.

5. **When are my SCRIP gift cards available?** SCRIP orders will be completed at the frequency determined by the OAYHA SCRIP coordinator. Typically an order will be placed every other Sunday or Monday with the arrival the following Wednesday or Thursday.

6. **If I forget or miss a pick up?** Please try to make the scheduled pick up date & time. If you cannot or forget, you will have to contact one of the SCRIP coordinators to set up other arrangements for pick up at their convenience.

7. **Does OAYHA carry an inventory of SCRIP cards?** OAYHA will not carry an inventory of SCRIP cards. With the 10 days between the order due date and the order pick up date, OAYHA should be able to fill all your orders.

8. **What can my skater's earnings be applied to?** You can apply your skater's earnings only at registration time, for registration fees. It may not be applied to any other expenses/fees.



9. **What if I lose my SCRIP cards/certificates?** SCRIP is just like cash. If it gets lost, it's gone. No replacements! It's for this reason that we require that you sign for your SCRIP when you pick it up.

10. **How do I pay for SCRIP?** SCRIP can only be purchased online through the use of PrestoPay through the families account on Raiseright.com. Each family's account is an agreement between the family and Raiseright, OAYHA is not responsible for any overdraft fees or penalties incurred while using SCRIP.

11. **How do I receive my "Program Code"?** OAYHA SCRIP coordinator will provide that code on successful completion of the Scrip Agreement. Please do not share the code with others, only those on file with a Scrip Agreement will be acknowledged as valid participants in the program.

12. **Can I use my SCRIP funds to pay for skater fees with the Ice Hawks?** Yes.

13. **Wait a minute, how does SCRIP work?** When you purchase gift cards for local and online businesses – each business gives a percentage back to the buyer. Of that percentage, 80% will go to the participant/designated skater and 20% will go to OAYHA itself. (i.e. Cabela's gives 11% back on the purchases of a card of any denomination. If you purchase a \$100 gift card, \$8.80 goes to the participant/designated skater's account, \$2.20 goes to the OAYHA.) That 20% helps OAYHA offset the costs of programming and operating expenses.
