



**THA Board Meeting February 10, 2026
J. Peppers Kernersville**

Call to Order: Jack called the meeting to order at 5:38

Meeting Minutes:

1. Jeremy made a motion that the minutes from the January 2026 meeting as captured by Lisa are approved. Joe provided the 2nd motion and none were opposed.
2. Looking to convert from Sports Engine to Crossbar. Built better, more modern, easy to use, registration is easier. Costs are similar, likely less than Sports Engine. Conversion would take 2-4 weeks.
3. Working on tryouts schedule, structure and evaluators.
4. Marian seminar will be May 2-3 at the Center for Creative Leadership. Times will be announced soon and registration will be built in Sports Engine.
5. Pre tryout clinic will be for 6 weeks starting in March at the annex. Will be on different practice days than the Gate City selects.
6. Gate City selects registration went out, lots of registrations already. Will have 2 practices per week, 4 tournaments.
7. Will hold Sunday skills sessions for 15 weeks from May to August. \$40 per session. Partner with Christian and will split ice time. Jack will meet with Connie to discuss funding and billing.
8. Christian looking to expand goalie offerings next year. Will work with him on structure and pay.
9. Jan is working on a summer athletics program.
10. The SPxTHA camp will occur again this summer.
11. Suggest to communicate all programs together to show different skills being targeted.
12. 13 applications for board positions. Mike spoke with applicants to explain what board is expecting.
13. Will review board positions in March meeting and will elect in April meeting.
14. Jeremy nominated Sally to continue in role as scheduler for next season. Sally has been reconciling bills to ice schedule and finding discrepancies.
15. Plan to update contracts, have salary conversation and approve in March meeting.
16. Apparel takes up a lot of Sally's time, could look for someone to potentially help with that.
17. Many rec coaches not complete with paperwork/certifications. Next season will need to make sure all of this gets done. Can consider covering some of these costs in the new budget.
18. Have received 7-8 coach applications so far, reaching out to adult league players.
19. Plan to revisit coach salaries. Currently \$3,000 for parents and \$5,000 for non parents. Will consider recent costs to travel.
20. Need to start conversations now with rinks on ice prices, jersey/apparel estimates, league fees, training for coaches and program structure for next season budget.
21. Discussion around rec structure for next season, possibly look at dividing into age groups.
22. Board candidates will be up on website for a week and then voting will be for 2 weeks and close on February 27. Will be filling 4 seats.
23. The annual meeting will be on April 12 at the Hampton Inn in Kernersville.
