SLVYHA Volunteer Role · Game Day

THE QUICK VERSION

What it is: Keeps the official game record at home games using the GameSheet app on an iPad, goals, assists, penalties, and the final score.

Time commitment: Roughly 90 minutes to 2 hours, a bit more than the game itself to allow for setup and post-game steps.

When: Home games and sometimes tournaments, at the scorer's table.

Requirements: No special certification for this game-day role.

Good for you if: You like being close to the action, can stay focused for a full game, and are comfortable tapping through a simple app.

Can you still watch your kid play? Yes, you're rinkside the whole game, though your attention is on tracking the play.

WHAT YOU'LL DO

- Score the game on the iPad using the GameSheet app, it replaces the old paper scoresheet
 - Record each goal with the scoring player and any assists, as called by the referees
 - Record penalties: player number, infraction, and length
 - Keep a quick note on paper as a backup in case you can't enter something in the moment
 - At the end, tap End Game and hand the iPad to the referees to sign off
 - Work alongside the timekeeper at the scorer's table
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HOW TO DO IT

- The refs will call each goal and penalty to the box, for example, "goal, white, number 3, assisted by number 12"
- Tap it into GameSheet as they call it: goals with scorer and assists, penalties with number, infraction, and length
- Jot events on paper too as a backup, there isn't always time to enter everything the instant it happens
- When the game ends, tap **End Game**, check for any errors the app flags, then hand the iPad to the referees for their post-game sign-off

See it before game day: GameSheet has a full set of help articles and training videos for the iPad scoring app. You can skip the install and sign-in parts (ours is already set up) and browse whatever you want to learn, scoring, penalties, ending the game:

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WHAT'S PROVIDED VS. WHAT YOU BRING

Provided: The iPad, fully set up with the game and rosters loaded, plus paper and a pen at the table for backup notes.

You bring: Nothing. Just show up ready to focus.

WHAT "DONE WELL" LOOKS LIKE

Goals and penalties are entered accurately, the final score is correct, the game is ended in the app, and the iPad is handed to the referees to sign off. Your paper backup matches.

WHO TO ASK WHEN YOU'RE STUCK

Reports to / coordinates with: Team manager.

HOW TO SIGN UP

Contact the team manager, or the Director of Operations if there is no team manager, and we'll get you started.

What happens after you sign up: We'll follow up with a game date and show you the ropes at the table.
