

AT-LARGE BOARD MEMBER (3 POSITIONS)

SLVYHA Volunteer Role · Governing Board

THE QUICK VERSION

What it is: A voting member of the Governing Board who takes on special functions as assigned. A flexible way to serve on the board without a fixed officer title.

Time commitment: Varies with assigned functions; expect regular board meeting attendance plus assigned duties.

When: Year-round; monthly board meetings plus assigned work.

Term: 3-year term. Elected by the membership. There are three at-large seats.

Requirements: - Open to any association member 18 or older - Once elected, meet board participation requirements (attend at least 75% of meetings)

Good for you if: You want a real voice and vote on the board and are open to taking on whatever the association needs.

WHAT YOU'LL DO

- Serve as a full voting member of the Governing Board
 - Take on special functions and duties as assigned by the board, year to year
 - Help manage the property and affairs of SLVYHA
 - Attend and participate in monthly board meetings
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HOW TO DO IT

- Attend board meetings and vote on motions
 - Take on the specific role/duties the board assigns your seat
 - Contribute to board decisions and the association's direction
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WHAT'S PROVIDED VS. WHAT YOU BRING

Provided: A seat and vote on the board, and defined duties as assigned.

You bring: Commitment, attendance, and willingness to help where needed.

WHAT "DONE WELL" LOOKS LIKE

You show up, vote, carry your assigned duties, and contribute to a functioning, mission-

focused board.

WHO TO ASK WHEN YOU'RE STUCK

Reports to / coordinates with: The President and the Governing Board.

HOW TO RUN FOR THIS ROLE

Elected each April at the annual meeting; new members begin at the May meeting. Nominations go to the Secretary in writing before the annual meeting. When a seat opens mid-term, the board may appoint someone to finish the term.

1. Be nominated / submit nomination to the Secretary
 2. Election by secret ballot at the annual meeting
