

This leads me to my FROZEN FOCUS tip of the month, being creative. Creativity is a big part of hockey. As I mentioned in last month's newsletter, no goal is the same as the last. I spent a lot of time on the frozen pond/lake growing up in Wisconsin and I believe that is what makes hockey so special. Some of the best players in every league make plays that are unscripted and off the narrative, just like playing a pickup game on the pond. I encourage everyone to take some time, if able, to find a pond, lake, or outdoor arena and just spend some time skating and playing with no set drills or structure. It gives everyone a chance to enjoy hockey history of how the game started and to play the game with an open mind. Sometimes we get so caught up in the positioning and structure of the game that we forget that playing with an open mind can sometimes be the most effective. So bundle up, get outside, grab some pucks, and find some empty ice and go have fun!!

PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1.No swearing or abusive language on the bench, in the rink or at any team function.
- 2. No bullying or harassment tolerated, including in person, behind the scenes or via any social media platforms.
- 3. Players shall not use phones, cameras or recording devices in the locker rooms.
- 4. No lashing out at any official no matter what the call is. The coaching staff will handle all matters pertaining to officiating.
- 5. Anyone who receives a penalty will skate directly to the penalty box. Fighting will not be tolerated.
- 6. Fighting will result in an appearance before a Discipline Committee.
- 7. There will be no drinking, smoking, chewing of tobacco or use of illegal substance at any team function.
- 8.I will conduct myself in a befitting manner at all facilities (ice rink, hotel, restaurant, etc) during all team functions.
- 9. Any player or team official who cannot abide by these rules or violates them will be subject to further disciplinary action that could include, but is not limited to, missing shifts, sitting games, suspension and/or expulsion from the Program.
