SKATES & ATTIRE

Skaters are required to wear fitted work out clothing to practice. It is expected that hair be pulled back, warm up jackets may not have hoods. No baggy t-shirts, jeans, hats or loose sweatpants/snowpants. Proper attire allows coaches to effectively see a skater's posture, alignment, and general overall skills. Helmets are optional. Skates **MUST** be staff approved. Please contact us prior to purchasing skates.
