-Chris plans to request a meeting with the City Park Director, Drew, to see if there is a way to lower the current fees of \$13 per hour, per court.

USTA- Currently we have 3.0 18+, 3.5 18+ & 40+ 7.0 combo teams.
Next USTA season is Mixed Doubles. We hope to have one PTA team, so far no captain has stepping up.
-Home matches are going well at the Casa Grande tennis courts.

Events: PTA would like to hold a Round Robin in June at Casa Grande courts as a celebration of National Tennis Month (May). This would be a fundraising kickoff for resurfacing the Casa courts.

-Those attending liked the idea, however no date was chosen and both Event board members were absent.

Court Maintenance Updates:

Chris had/has visits/walk throughs at the Casa High courts with the USTA representative as well as with David Jefferson from Decking Around, the group that recently resurfaced Petaluma High School courts.

-PTA could possibly receive a matching grant from the USTA, they are interested in helping school tennis courts.

Chris also meet with the vice principal of Casa Grande and they talked about the need for new lights on the courts.
