

Winter Training Program

- Strength and Conditioning and Catchers clinic will be released weekly on Sunday Mornings
- Waiting list gets first choice the following week
- Booking will be available at Bataviabaseball.com/travel NEED THIS SET UP
- Winter Training Runs 12 weeks 1/5/26 3/29/26
- Players show up 10 minutes early to warm-up Warmups will be provided
- Always bring other shoes (shoes worn outside are not allowed on the turf)
- Always wear Baseball Pants, Hat and Batavia baseball shirt
- Need 2 coaches to run sessions
- When sessions finish and the team is talking, the next team should come onto the turf without disturbing discussion (this will help the flow of training).

Arrival/Departure	Unlock storage, inspect for hazards	Lock Storage, Clean garbage, sweep and empty dugout
Field	Rake home and mound, clay in holes, water dirt	Rake away from grass, Clay holes
Lines & bases	Chalk foul lines and batters box, install bases	Reinsert base plugs

Maintaining Fields – Heavy Rain

BYB will close fields as promptly as possible. If field needs work, please follow these guidelines.

- Remove as much water as possible
 - Spong water into buckets and dump outside the field
 - Never use brooms or push water of the field
- Add Conditioner
 - Rake in field conditioner sparingly
 - Do not attempt to turn the dirt over
- If field still needs work, reach out to field rep
 - Do not use quick dry unless you get permission from the board first

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What to Expect of Regular Season

Season runs 4/1/26 – 6/30/26 (Playoffs until 7/12/26)

Minimum of 16 League games + playoffs

Teams are separated into divisions based on skill level: A, AA, AAA, Elite

16 teams get into the playoffs in each division

5 or more tournaments, 3 – 4 game guarantee + bracket play


Minimum 28 games, should be less then 50

Most league games will occur during the week




What to Expect of Tournaments

- Tournaments typically consist of 2-3 pool play games
- Teams are seeded and then go to bracket play
- Rules change! (know tournament rules)
- 4 local or away tournaments and a home tournament
- Additional tournaments on an individual team basis
- Home tournament is all volunteer based
 - Team tournament administrator will likely create a sign up genius

Scheduling

RSVP all events, Especially declining events (Coaches look)

GC is always the source of truth

Calendar sync works very well



Scoring/Stats

Great for live updates

Easy to lookup opponents for league play, tournaments or friends and family

NEVER COMPARE to teammates, stats (especially errors) vary wildly based on scorekeeper

Monitoring stats may show individual trends



Great for Gramma, but she'll hear everything.

Easy player clips, but May require subscription or community pass
