## Reid Wiley Memorial Scholarship









Reid Wiley was an active athlete in many different competitive sports including Hockey, Paint Ball and Disc Golf. Reid was born in Kitchener, Ontario, Canada on September 3, 1992. He was a fun loving kid who enjoyed participating in all sports but found his passion learning to skate and ultimately playing hockey. Reid moved to Medina, Ohio in the spring of 2000 with his family and began his USA Hockey career playing in Parma, Ohio for 2 years and winning Championships as part of that organization. Reid transitioned to Strongsville Youth Hockey and continued his successful minor hockey career winning championships at the Peewee and Bantam levels. Reid went on to play for the Cleveland Junior Jacks, Medina High School, Wooster Oilers Jr. team and finally ended his career playing 5 years for the University of Akron.

Reid was a fighter both on and off the ice. He had asthma from a very young age which made it very difficult for his hockey career as well as off the ice. On December 29, 2020 Reid lost his life to complications from Asthma. His death was sudden and a shock to everyone he knew and was particularly difficult on his family.

Reid's best friend and hockey teammate Aaron Musick began a Scholarship Fund shortly after Reid's passing in an effort to give kids that possessed the same attributes as Reid an opportunity to play the game they both loved. The fundraising expanded to encompass the Reid Wiley Charity Golf Outing which increased the funding for the Scholarships. Due to the initiative and charitable act of kindness initiated by Aaron Musick we are able to fund the Reid Wiley Memorial Scholarship.

The Reid Wiley Memorial Scholarship is dedicated to offering funding for those in need and those that possess the individual and team characteristics that Reid so proficiently delivered every day.





#### **ELIGIBILITY**

- ✓ Must be a member of the Strongsville Youth Hockey Club
- ✓ Must have played for the SYHC for a minimum of one year and be returning for a subsequent season
- ✓ Candidates must posses the same personal and team characteristics as Reid Wiley
- ✓ Applicant must possess and have displayed the following:
  - o Commitment to hard work on and off the ice
  - Team first over self
  - Loyalty to teammates
  - Play with passion and have a "Do Whatever It Takes" attitude
- ✓ Applicants must posses a minimum "B" average in school

#### **CRITERIA**

- ✓ The candidate must submit a short essay (250-500 words) describing why they believe they embody the same characteristics as Reid and provide specific examples
- ✓ The candidate must have their coach submit a short essay (250-500 words) explaining how the player has demonstrated the characteristics of commitment to hard work on and off the ice, team over self, loyalty and a "Do Whatever It Takes" attitude. Coach's recommendations play a significant role in the selection process
- ✓ Submit any other additional or pertinent information about the applicant you feel would helpful

Complete the attached application form and submit it with the required attachments no later than March 1<sup>st</sup>:

- ✓ Submit completed application form
- ✓ Submit the Essay from the Candidate
- ✓ Submit the Essay from the Coach
- ✓ Submit a copy of transcript or report card for the current school year

Applications will be reviewed by all members of the The Wiley Foundation and will select the winners in the spring (usually April)

The Scholarship will be presented to the selected applicants and the Scholarship will be paid to the Club to cover the upcoming season dues for the winning applicants (up to \$1500 max).
