Equipment

- Every player will receive a Home and Away Game Jersey, game socks, a practice jersey, water bottle, De Smet Hockey Polo Shirt and Pullover Jerseys will be distributed prior to the first game and must be turned in at end of season.
- Varsity and Swing players will also get a Blue 3rd Jersey + Blue Socks (to be turned in at end of the Season)
- All incoming Freshman and new players will receive a De Smet Hockey Shell
 - Returning players who need a replacement will need to purchase new shell for \$50
- All players, regardless of team, are expected to wear De Smet color gloves and helmets at all games (no club team gloves or club helmets)
- Neck Guards are MANDATORY [you will not be allowed to enter the ice without a neck guard]
- Yellow Helmet Reimbursement (for Varsity and Swing Players only)
 - \$175 (1X reimbursement)
 - Must submit receipt by January 1, 2025, to desmethockeyclub@gmail.com

- Custom-Ordered De Smet Gloves are due to deliver by mid-October

Student Attendance Policy


De Smet wants its students to grow through experiences outside of school but maintain the De Smet Community (in-person, instruction on campus)

Attendance reviews at the end of each academic quarter – failure to meet required instruction time could result in academic penalties and the loss of academic credits as well as sports and activity eligibility

- No penalties until the semester ends
- Students can miss up to 7 days for each academic class without penalty total of 14 days per semester (A & B Class days)
- Up to 30 days per school year
- Since it's launch, there's been a real shift in communication ahead of time
- De Smet is trying to balance the policy across all sports and all student activities
- The De Smet Hockey Club wants to do our best to comply
- It's critical that all families and students communicate with the school when a student will not be on campus
- Be smart about your days out of school limit your absenteeism especially if you are in travel hockey





Team Liaisons are responsible for individual team needs and primary coordinator to include the following:


- Team social events before and or after games as necessary


