Conduct Committee

- Majority of issues occurred in late Jan / Feb.
 - 10 out of approximately 12 incidents during this timeframe.
 - Several had multiple outcomes or follow-ups.
- There is also a pattern of waiting instead of reporting.
 - The "this has been long enough" mentality
 - Needs to be reported to end issues sooner
 - By the time the report is filled, the Committee unravels multiple related issues between the parties.
- Next Season:
 - Address it more clearly at next season's parent's meeting.
 - Send parents, coaches, & players reminders of code of conduct after Christmas as a refresher.
 - We are non-profit which means we have to offer the opportunity to everyone, unless there is numerous documented events to not allow someone
 - Communication needs to be clear with parents as well
 - Can we make an expectation of the coach?
 - Coach should have forwarded it to the Director of Hockey or Conduct Committee
 - Example: Skater hitting others with a stick, so we can take away the stick for practice
 - ♦ If there are multiple issues all going on at the same time, then it needs to go to Conduct Committee
 - Need to make the "report" more acceptable
