
Enrollment: 14 (13 in 2023-24)

## Survey Feedback



#### Player Development and Growth

- All teams saw huge growth in both skill and team development – many callouts for the coaches and program
- Requests for skill-specific improvements (e.g., shooting, passing, skating)
- More regular individualized feedback
- Goalie development opportunities
- Interest in additional summer camps and more communication about off-season development opportunities

#### Team Composition

- Overall high scores for coaches and managers
- Some feedback about the team selection process and requests for more transparency
- One team per age group can create large skill gaps
- Coaches were praised for playing kids equally (rec program!), but some concerns that playing time should align to practice time

#### General Program Feedback

- 9.2 out of 10 for recommending SSYHA well done
- More integration and scrimmages with other local teams
- Suggestion for clearer volunteer expectations and requested documentation to hand out to parents (e.g., clock, penalty box)
- Better early-season communication about travel and expenses.
- Desire for more program swag for kids to wear


#### Organizational Leadership and Coaching

- Coaches need to work on consistent expectations between players
