

TIMEKEEPER INSTRUCTIONS

New England Girls Hockey League Games (GU8 National)

Three 12 Minute periods

1:00 Minute Penalty (Minor)

New England Girls Hockey League Games (GU10-GU14)

Three 15 Minute periods

1:30 Minute Penalty (Minor)

Middlesex Yankee Girls Hockey League Games

Three 12 Minute periods

1:00 Minute Penalty (Minor)

Premier Hockey League

Two 22.5 minute periods stop time for all games.

Plus one (1) time out per team per game is allowed.

2:00 Minutes (Minor)

5:00 Minutes (Major)

10:00 Minutes (Misconduct)

Home Team goaltender will start furthest from their bench.

SETTING THE WARM UP TIME

- Set clock to 3 minutes for warm up prior to start of game
- Start warm up time as soon as the skaters are on the ice and run until buzzer.
- Set the clock to 12 minutes (or 15) for the FIRST period. (and each period after)
- The buzzer will sound automatically after time runs out of each period.

SETTING GAME TIME (General Instructions)

1. Hit the SET MAIN CLOCK button.

2. Type in the time and hit the ENTER button. . Ex. 3 minutes, type in 3000.
(The extra zero is for tenths of seconds)
3. To run the time hit the START button; to stop the time hit the STOP button.
4. To enter the periods, hit the PERIOD+ button until you have the desired period on the scoreboard.
5. To reset the time after a period, repeat steps 1 & 2.

STARTING AND STOPPING THE TIME

1. Press the START button to run the time; press STOP to stop the time.
 - During each period, press START as soon as the puck touches the ice after the ref drops it
 - Press STOP every time the ref blows the whistle. The ref will look for your "OK" at the start of each period.
 - If you have entered a penalty during a period, the penalty time will automatically STOP each time you STOP the main clock.

ENTERING SCORE

Press the SCORE +1 or SCORE -1 button under HOME or GUEST to increase or decrease the score.

ENTERING PENALTIES

1. Hit the PLAYER/PENALTY button under HOME or GUEST
 2. Type in the player number
 3. Hit the ENTER button.
 4. Type in the penalty time. Ex. A 1:00 penalty, hit 100. (Double check the scoreboard control display)
 5. Hit the ENTER button.
- The ref will come and report the number of the player and the penalty.
 - Clock automatically starts and stops penalty time

NOTE: You can enter up to 6 simultaneous penalties on the controller. Only 2 at a time will show on the scoreboard. Once the first penalty expires, the third will start counting down.

REMOVING PENALTIES

To clear all penalties for a team, hit CLEAR ALL PENALTIES and then ENTER to confirm.

OR

1. Hit the DELETE PENALTY button under HOME or GUEST.
2. Hit the UP or DOWN ARROW key until the penalty you need to remove shows on the scoreboard control display (check player number and time remaining to make sure you have the correct one if there are multiple penalties on the clock).
3. Hit the ENTER button.

ENABLE/DISABLE PENALTY TIMERS

If a penalty crosses periods, and you need to set the clock for the next period, press the DISABLE PENALTY CLOCKS button. This will prevent the penalty time from counting down with the main clock. At the beginning of the next period, press the ENABLE PENALTY CLOCKS button to start the penalty time counting down again.
