

Things You Should Know

- We're using the USA Hockey 2021-25 Rulebook
- Hockey has evolved since you played or is different from what you see on TV
 - Emphasis on...
 - Fair Play and Respect/Zero Tolerance Policy
 - Player Safety The focus of a body check must be to gain possession of the puck, not to punish or intimidate the other players.







Some Playing Rule Reminders

- Icing is ALWAYS called, regardless of team's on-ice strength
- Offside is ALWAYS automatic (no tag-up)
- Mouthguards are REQUIRED at U12 and older
- Faceoff after a penalty is in the defending zone of the penalized team
- Offside faceoff location is where the puck originated from
 - Intentional offside is different





2022 - 2023 Results

- Excellent budget discipline along with great fundraising activities resulted in significant favorability to budget
- Budget Highlights:
 - Ice Spend favorable to budget \$13,530.75
 - Blades Blastoff \$6,000
 - Conservative budget approach on teams and skater numbers
 - Excellent fundraising revenue from scrip, pizza, kringle, mite holiday classic
 - Enabled \$40,000 contribution to parking lot!

2023 – 2024 Budget

- Conservative budget includes upside for tournament and other fundraising opportunities
- Lower revenue driven by decision not to hold bantam tournament
- Budgeted loss includes:
- 5% increase in ice time (more older teams)
- \$15,000 allowance for non-parent coaching
- All funded through reserves!



2022-2023 Volunteer Recap:
