How and when do I Volunteer?

Music Operator – All Season

We need a parent volunteer to operate the music system during club ice sessions. This is a regular weekly commitment and one of the most important volunteer roles in the club. Sign up through Crossbar.

Run Rabbit Run — Our Biggest Fundraiser

September 18–19 at Olympian Hall, Howelsen Hill. SSC volunteers at the aid station during this iconic Steamboat trail race. Last year we earned \$10,000 for the club! We need ALL families to participate — skaters and parents alike. Shifts are available and families with skaters under 12 must have an adult present.

Fall Fundraiser – September 1 through November 29th

Our annual fall fundraiser supports club programming and operations. Details announced in the newsletter — watch for ways your family can participate and help us reach our goal.

Bake Sales – October & November

Bake sales are held at competitions and club events throughout the year. Donations of baked goods and volunteers to staff the table are always needed. Watch the newsletter for upcoming bake sale dates.

Halloween Skate – October 25th

These fun community skating events need volunteers to help with setup, costumes, music, decorations, and running the event. A great opportunity for the whole family to get involved and celebrate the season.

Winter Holiday Skate — December (Date TBD)

Spring Ice Show – January through March

Our Spring Ice Show is one of the highlights of the season and takes a village to pull off. Volunteers are needed for setup and breakdown, backstage support, costume assistance, ticket sales, programs, and more.
