## **Other Important Details**

### 1. Practice

- a. Practice will occur 4 days a week Including one strength day. It's mandatory that Varsity players schedule personal activities and work activities AROUND the practice and game schedule.
- b. Players should communicate their priorities to the team to parents regarding scheduling family activities where appropriate.

### 2. Grades and School

- a. All players are required to maintain a 2.0 GPA or above when the first official grades are reported in the spring
- b. Players must attend school/GED Program in order to participate. Players must attend school the day of practice/games in order to play

### 3. Illegal Substance/Abuse

- a. Players will be held to the highest lawful, community, and school standard regarding substance abuse and will receive team consequences in addition to school, family, lawful punishments.

### 4. Parent/Guardian Involvement

- a. All parents and/or guardians are expected to help regarding the smooth running of the season. Duties are as follows:
