NEW BUSINESS

a. April 26 Tournament Postmortem

- i) Need a sign directing to handicapped access porta potty.
- ii) Many balls stolen. Possibility of scorekeepers/timekeepers picking up and keeping balls at table until needed.
- iii) We had 20 balls per field. Jason checking if we need more.
- iv) Have a cooler with drinks for field 6, as refs can't get to the concessions quickly enough to get drinks between games.
- v) We may have to pay more fees at the end of the year to BVLA.
- vi) It is about \$1000 in ref fees with \$700 coming back. So about \$360 we end up paying.
