APPROVAL OF MINUTES

NEW BUSINESS

a. Discussion of U14 Team Options

- i) We have 30 kids in our U14 team and registration is still open. Splitting the team into two teams of 15 means 5 subs per team. With vacations, other sports going on, and injuries, the chances of it being fewer than 15 at a game is high.
- ii) The financial cost of another team is \$200 roughly per weekend tournament. We owe for ½ of the reefing fees. The club would struggle under the added financial burden.
- iii) Kids would have to play more games to accommodate more teams. Many back-to-back and switching between teams isn't allowed regardless of what other teams have done in the past.
- iv) Kids are not allowed to age down.
- v) Discussion on what were some challenges last year with a large team. Some kids did not get much or any playing time while others played the entire game. Subbing was said to have not worked well. It was noted that kids should get to play no matter what. Club President stated that he was committed to addressing these concerns.
- vi) Discussion of the coaches ideas for changing out entire lines/fields of players, how effort and attitude will play into coaching decisions, and consideration that this will be a work in progress.
