The meeting was called to order at 7:25 pm by Pete Kraguljac.

Approval of Minutes: Motion carried to approve the August 4, 2022, minutes: Nancy (1), Kevin (2) 9-0-0.

Visitors' Business: Russ from Visual Sports

- Used to do our photos for many years, many years ago.
- Enjoys taking team photos; not building individual photos into a team photo
- Shoots against a green screen and adds edgy art
- Yearbooks: they did them for us years ago and we received # for free
- Now: he can give us free yearbooks, or he can give us fundraising check (and we sell yearbooks to parents)
- Sponsor plagues are free
- Starting to offer team banners, at very low prices
- Since last time they did our photos, they now offer online ordering. Looking to upgrade mobile end of website
- There is a fundraising program built into what is sold; we get the money and decide what we want to do with it. (i.e. take the cash; put it toward banners; offer free yearbooks, etc.)
- 3x5 banners are \$30 (i.e. senior shots; sponsor banners)
- He will give Sarah his cell phone: he will respond to calls/texts, after he goes to Pounders 😊



Hockey Committee

- Schedule
 - Scheduling is done. It's crazy complicated.
 - Kevin will be a check-and-balance for Brad and Todd; he will check every two weeks to make sure we're not missing anything
 - Monday: Pete, Sarah and Brad are meeting with Red 1 and to go through all requirements.
- Coaches' meetings
 - Coaching requirements: everyone is done except for Bantam coaches
- Mite placements
 - 69 Mites and 48 Mini Mites
- Mini Mites
 - There will be a couple coaches/people in charge paying attention to the bottom half to determine which 5-10 Mites can go down to Mighty Mites or Mini Mites.

- We can't have over-crowded ice because it's not good for development; it's hard on the coaches; it doesn't make sense.
- USA Hockey suggests 10 kids per station, with two coaches in a station. So a max of 60 kids on ice
- Pete and Brad plan to meet with Ken and Nancy to discuss Mini Mites.
- New: John Egan got ahold of guy in Arizona. We can get 4 nets for \$1900 in 3 weeks.
- Kevin: If we're going to send Minis down, we should host a Town Hall to let parents know some kids might go down.
- Mandi: When Mites get placed, will we send them an invite to join their teams?
 Pete: Yes. And we can say they have 48 hours in advance to accept.
 Pete: I'm all for having a Town Hall with the Mites; he's happy to be there to talk Will say "we're going to move you down to a new program we have, called Mighty Mites. We can't field 5 blue teams; we want them to be able to play."
- Brad: Bob and Brad will hold Town Halls before placements
- Ryan: For all the teams who are doing tournaments, they should have their blackout dates submitted. The coaches were asked to submit them. And will be asked again after placements

President's Report:

- Scholarship fund
 - Riley Reed wants to give us a lot of money, but there's a lot that goes with it
 - His son died of asthma
 - Coach has to submit application; skater has to write essay
 - They will award it, and skater will win free fee for next season if they stay at Parma
 - A child who exhibits the traits of a captain on and off the ice
 - Kevin: allow all the kids to write essays
 - Pete: they want a coach to nominate a child
 - \$7500-\$10,000 per year to play with, indefinitely
 - One from each level; has to be nominated by the coach;
 - Kevin: it's a lot of pressure for the coach; I would not want to deal with the blow-back from the parents who were not selected
- Budget extension
 - Not now; need to wait until we have accurate Mite count

Pete TO DO: budget for next meeting

- Preseason scheduling
 - September 17
- Scheduling for Mite coaching interviews
 - The week of the 24th, all Mite coaches will be interviewed (Sept 26-30)
 - We'll send out coaching applications
 - Numbers should be done and in Crossbar, except for Mites and people new to PHA.
 - The store will be open for a limited time for jerseys and spiritwear; so it will be the one order for Christmas.
 Cherie TO DO: Make sure this is communicated.
 - Jerseys: next year, we need to order them sooner.
 - Mandi and Sarah manually check all Mites for numbers, as the system doesn't do it for Mites (for some reason)
 - Sarah: If everyone wants to re-open the store for Christmas, that's fine. But he said people order more if they order all together.

- Pete to Brad: Let's do Mite placements in August. Rent ice from somewhere and get it done.
- Banner ceremony
 - Do we want to do one? We used to do it earlier, but now we don't get them until later
 - Maybe we do it once Open Skate starts
 - Have the city hang them and cover them; then we'll pick a date to unveil
- The rock
 - Plaque will be taken off and will be replaced
