• Approval of Minutes: Motion carried to approve May 4, 2023, minutes: Jon (1) Nancy (2) 8-0-0.

• Visitors' Business: None

#### Hockey Committee:

- Monsters Event
  - Event went well; they did a good job with it
  - Rink staff was very helpful
  - Half Parma kids; half other kids
  - Next year we should say all Mites have to be from PHA, since so many on ice
- Summer Skates
  - 70+ kids. Made about \$300 profit at first sessions
  - Red Mite players and a few other Mites will practice with the Squirts in future sessions so we have more room for Mites on the ice.
  - A ton of Mightys were there.
  - Pete: Should we charge for goalies and coaches' kids?
- Roster updates
  - Tuck is still at 11
  - Baetzel is at 12, looking for more, with the right fit
  - Kaden Hatch will play goalie for Squirt 2 and Squirt 3
    - We are looking into how to do it properly, so it doesn't affect playoffs, etc.
  - Nate Hunt needs a few more skaters; there are a few skaters we are keeping an eye on; it will be a team decision after Summer Skates
  - Brief discussion about scheduling for Mite team (half ice to start; full ice in second half)

## • President's Report:

- Club team
  - Valley Forge is not going to have a team
  - School district refused to interview anyone for Normandy, except one
  - No one knows what's going on with Holy Name (8 hockey players)

- Apparently, parents complained to city that PHA takes all the ice
- Joe Gaudino from Parma High is very interested in Club hockey (Parma Flyers U18)
  - They'd play in same division with Media, Team Ohio, etc.
  - Club will have to figure out financials.
  - The only thing they would do is use our uniform kit and we'd bring them in for scheduling.
  - Benefit to having a club level high school team is it's one way to not lose Bantams
  - Pete will meet with Gaudino and go over financials
  - Sarah: another fundraising opportunity would be to offer Nickel Hockey our ice to buy for a tournament and then we make money
  - Pete: Halloween weekend is league scheduling; that's a good weekend to book an outside tournament on our ice, as coaches will be busy

## • Vice President's Report:

- Association tournament
  - Want to move it to earlier in the season
  - It was fairly easy to work with Nickel City Hockey (Matt Peters)
  - Earlier tournaments are in Utica, NY. Brand new rink; hotels are 5 minutes away.
    - Can offer team discounts and put us in same hotel or next to each other
    - Sara and Pete: Utica is ghetto
    - Other options are Buffalo or Niagara in February
    - Sarah sent Matt Peters a message about doing RiverWorks in Buffalo in Feb
      - Per Matt Peters: RiverWorks isn't available; he can do things to make outside work
      - So most likely Association Tourney will be in Niagara, 2/17-2/19
- Pure Hockey jerseys
  - Store opens for 2 weeks; delivery is 8 weeks from that date
  - Sara: When they start to order their jerseys, we'll have to figure what goalies are ordering, as Sara will have to pay for them (as comp for paying tryout fee)
  - Pete: If you played Mites last year, you can order your jersey
  - Pete: If you were in Mini or Mighty last year, you can't order a jersey now
  - Pete: I would like different color jerseys for Minis and Mightys this year
  - Sarah: Everyone Telegram Sarah by tomorrow with any questions regarding Spiritwear
- Parade
  - Sarah posted flyer on Telegram
  - Pete to send Sarah updated logo to post on Facebook
  - Nancy talked to Jimmy and said we can use his parking lot
  - Nancy to spend up to \$100 for candy
- Welcome Back
  - Jimmy will bring ice cream truck; we'll figure out food (pizza vs. burgers) later
  - Saturday, September 9, 12:00 2:30 (depending on ice cuts)

- Picture dates
  - All of October is open, but not everyone will have jerseys
  - Pete: Do it the last weekend in October during scheduling weekend
  - Sarah: Pictures will be Monday, 10/23 and 10/24
