Hockey Committee

- Mite placements
 - 70 Mites registered, including Mite 1. So 56 need-to-be-placed Mites are registered.
 - Red 1 will get full sheet of ice by themselves in September.
 - Each week, Mites will get 1 weekday and 2 weekend ice slots
 - Saturday, Sept. 24 and Sunday, Sept. 25 will be on-ice placements
 - The week of September 26 will be coaches' interviews
 - (Saturday, Sept. 17 is CSHL pre-season scheduling via Zoom)
 - Some coaches will watch skaters during September ADM to determine if some should be Mini Mites
 - Ideally, we would like 50 Mites at ADM ice sessions this season
 - Sarah: Would like us announce if your Mite is not registered by 9/1, you may not come to September ADM-style skating or placements.
 - Cherie: put on Telegram
 - Sarah: Mites who have previously played for Parma and have not registered yet need to do so now, and before Sept. 1. Registration will close after Sept. 1
 - Pete: I assume we are missing 20 kids on the list who have not yet registered

PeeWee numbers

- PW1: 13 skaters and 2 goalies
- PW2: 10 skaters and a goalie
- PW3: 9 skaters and a goalie; both should have 11-12 skaters
- We're going to do some things where kids are double-rostered to help with the teams, as needed.
 - i.e. Will take some Squirt 2 kids and move up to PW 3, as needed
 - Note: AA teams (Red 1 and Squirt 1) cannot play up

• President's Report:

- Pete: Will order plaques for Hall of Fame tomorrow
- Working on a budget; should have at September meeting to review

• Vice President's Report

- Hall of Fame + Welcome Back event
 - Girls have been working really hard on HOF event
 - Guys only have a couple jobs; have to push Sign Up Genius
 - People don't' understand Sign Up Genius is an RSVP, not to work
 - Saturday, September 17, 5:00 pm 11:00 pm
 - Corn hole tournament will bring in ~\$700 profit
 - Wine pull will bring in ~\$500
 - As far as baskets, will add \$100 to each team's Team Funds (so team fees will be \$450). But we're not wording it as increasing the team fees. They are donating to the Association fundraiser, like they normally do. So since teams are not yet fully functioning as a team, we graciously created the \$100 baskets for them.
 - Not pushing sideboards, etc. as in the past, because Lottery will still be main fundraiser. So goal is to just break even and host a nice party for the Association. Ideally, we'll make money, though.
 - Last year we took money and paid a portion of the fees for the Association tournament. This year, since we're using money to host this event, we will not pay tournament fees
 - Reason we paid for it last year is because we did so well with lottery fundraiser.
 - This year, party is for free...so it's in lieu of paying for the tournament.
 - Inductees: Jerry Gunsley and Ken Ledford
 - Slide show of photos
 - Greenhill will give Ken's induction speech
 - Jerry's osn will give Jerry's induction speech
 - We are providing pizza, salad, chips, kegs of beer and wash (soda, water)
 - Guests can bring in own coolers with liquor
 - PHA members can bring anyone, but they have to RSVP so we have a count
 - Sign up will be coming out Friday, 8/5, for the cornhole tournament
 - 20 teams; 40 people; will bring in \$700
 - We need 6 corn hole board sets and bags
 - \$50/team to play
 - Payout is to first place team of \$300
 - Pay via Venmo to Sarah Stankiewicz
 - Sarah: push the event...put it on social media
 - Wine pull: 50 bottles of wine is goal
 - Ryan: push to bring the donated wine to the last two Parma Summer Ice practices
 - Need donations for Baskets

Break the Ice event

- Saturday, September 9, from 6:00 pm 8:00 pm
- It's on social media
- We have a Sign Up Genius
- We don't need much help
- We eat outside; open skate is the full two hours

- Holy Name locker room
 - Brecksville will get before school and at 4:00 p.m. times
 - We have first right of refusal for weekend games

Personal fundraising

- We fundraise for Parma hockey
- What you do on your own is fine
- But you can't have Parma Hockey's name on a ticket
- You can't use Parma Hockey's name to raise funds individually
- It takes away from team fundraising
- We limit team fundraising to two fundraisers/year so it doesn't get out of control
- As long as Parma's name is not on fundraiser, we can't control it
- We are a non-profit organization and can get in trouble with personal fundraisers
- Kevin: If you are not a 501c3, you have to pay taxes on what you raise
- Only time it's OK, is if teams vote to have some self-pay and the others fundraise
- Alcohol baskets: we always say no
 - Legally you are not allowed to auction off alcohol without a license
 - You can post it online; you cannot accept payment online
- Pete: Any use of our name or trademark needs written consent

Association tournament

- February 17 20, 2023, in Niagara, NY for Niagara Presidential Playdown
- Hosted by Nickel City Hockey
- (A different) Matt Peters is the organizer
- He has spots for everyone
- As far as the Mites, he'll work with other companies in the area, and if there's not a spot in this tournament, he'll get the team placed in another local tournament
- We'll be in two or three hotels near each other
- 10U-14U: Original entry price \$1,595...giving it to us for \$1,307
- Mite 1: \$1,300...getting it for \$1,066
- Half ice was: \$825...getting it for \$696
