 - Pete: Evaluators offer little value when get down to 2 and 3 teams; they are good at picking Top 10 kids.
 - Pete: great job at tryouts! Nice work.
 - Team roster updates
 - Summer ice
 - Waited too long; not much ice anywhere
 - Trying to get three hours in a row; maybe at Gilmour
 - May try to do dryland for Mites; Squirts and PeeWees do their own thing anyway
 - Sarah: maybe kids going into high school can help run dryland; they need volunteer hours

• President's Report:

- CSHL meeting update
 - Monsters did a clinic the other day about concussions, AED. They may do something for coaches.
 - They are going to do a mandatory score sheet training

 - NOTE: make a cheat-sheet for PP (PowerPlays, etc.).

 - Recent history:

 - We all need to help and bring in outside members to build stronger foundation
 - Ryan: We can't answer folks with sarcasm if they don't know us.
 - Kevin: As a board, we need to be level-headed and be sure we are de-escalating things, such as that ice touches are equal among teams
 - Sarah: Can we all defend the program enough? And involve the level rep
 - NOTE: Put Level Rep names at the top of the Minutes and agendas, to remind us

Pure Hockey

- Brian: We would sign an agreement with Pure Hockey
 - We would have a team store set up to order jerseys; each family would be responsible for ordering own equipment
 - Each time someone orders off the website, \$20 annually per family gets sent back to Parma. Money also goes to the teams.
 - Contract is once a year

- Sounds like he'll be able to match our jersey cost
- Spiritwear they only offer what they have in stock
- We need to give them 8 weeks to get the store set up
