The meeting was called to order at 6:19 pm by Pete Kraguljac.

• Approval of Minutes: Motion carried to approve July 13, 2023, minutes: Nancy (1) Tessa (2) 9-0-0.

Hockey Committee:

- Schedule meeting
 - Took place yesterday with Pete, Brad, Todd, and Kevin
 - Came up with creative ways to have a lot of ice before high school season starts.
 - Once HS season starts, touches for each team will reduce by about 1 per month
 - We will have more ice on Fridays.
 - Will try and keep Mondays, Tuesdays and Fridays consistent, i.e. "those are your team's days." Other days will vary and not be consistent.
 - We picked up Parma's old ice slots during Christmas, to use for the Mite tourney
 - We picked up a bit of Tuesday ice, but nothing noticeable
- Coaches meeting
 - Everyone showed up but Betzel and Coyne; they had prior commitments
 - Gave them deadlines for certain things
 - Decided there will be a team/parent/coach contract for every team in terms of discipline, accountability, etc. Teams can add to template at the end, to personalize for their team.
 - We have various existing versions, but we will put together one PHA version.
- Neck guards / mouth pieces
 - Minis will have neck guards
 - Everyone else (Mites and up) will be required to wear neck guards and mouth guards
 - Once rink opens, it will be zero tolerance for anyone not wearing neck and mouth guards
 - All Board members should be responsible for telling coaches if they see kids at practice/games not wearing neck/mouth guards
- Dryland
 - There will be two Mite drylands
 - Monday 8/21 and Monday 8/28 at time TBD

- Once the city okays them, we will put together a flyer
- Free of charge
- End-of-year reviews
 - This year we will institute a standard end-of-year review sheet to assess various points and suggest what to work on over the summer
 - Dates have been set for testing and evaluations
 - They will be on Sundays in mid-October and first week of February
 - Half of the ice will be the team's practice; other half with be evaluations
- Mite email
 - Need to get out email to Mites to let them know how September will be
 - Cherie to look up email from last year
- Power skating/on-ice training/goalie training
 - In years past, we've paid OHP to do power skating, etc., but it's very similar to what we offer in practices, so we are evaluating if we want to continue
 - OHP is \$150/hour; we usually spend \$450/month
 - We definitely want to continue the goalie clinics, as Baetzel will be less available since he's a head coach
 - Sarah: feedback from coaches is that OHP is better for older teams, to have a new "eye"
 - Pete: Maybe one day a month, we switch up coaches and have them coach other teams
 - Or pay Heather Galagus to do it once a month
 - Brad to check with Heather and talk with Chuck about goalie clinics
- Shooter tutors
 - It would be helpful for all teams to have shooter tutors
 - About \$1300 for two of them
 - Brian: it will last for many years
 - Brad to put together information and we can vote on it
 - Sarah: will they fit in our storage room? Yes

President's Report:

• Vice President's Report:

- Spiritwear
 - Ron from Rube Adler was spiritwear guy last year; he knows we went with Pure Hockey; he still created a store for us; Sarah explained we can't do anything with him. We cannot share it with our people. If it is from him (not PHA) to our managers, then we are OK with it. Customers have to pick up from his store; team managers will not do anything with it.
 - Brian: Did we get any complaints on Pure Hockey?
 - Shipping costs that were a flat \$15, no matter what you ordered.
