4. Player Expectations

- Attend all practices, games, and team meetings/meals unless excused in advance.
- Be on time and ready to compete.
- Respect all teammates, coaches, referees, and fans.
- Maintain passing grades and school eligibility.
- Represent the team positively in and out of school.

5. Parent Expectations

- Support the team through positive encouragement.
- Promote good sportsmanship
- Ensure timely transportation for your athlete when needed.
- Stay informed via team communication channels.

6. Practice & Game Policies

- Players should arrive 30 minutes before practice and must arrive 60 minutes before games.
- All absences must be reported to coaches in advance.
- Unexcused absences may result in reduced playing time.
- Team warm-ups and/or attire are mandatory.
- Playing time is earned and at the discretion of the coaching staff.

7. Academic Standards

- Players must maintain eligibility as determined by their home school district.
- Report cards may be reviewed by coaching staff.
- Tutoring and study time will be encouraged when needed
- Absences for School related reasons will be encouraged.

8. Code of Conduct

Players must:

- Obey school and team rules.
- Avoid drug, alcohol, and tobacco use.
- Demonstrate respect and sportsmanship at all times.
- Not post inappropriate or offensive content on social media.

Violations may result in suspension or dismissal from the team.

9. Disciplinary Actions

Violations of team rules may lead to:

- Verbal or written warnings
- Loss of playing time
- Suspension from games
- Dismissal from the team

All disciplinary actions are at the discretion of the coaching staff and in consultation with school officials.

10. Equipment & Uniform Guidelines

- Players are responsible for maintaining all team-issued gear, which includes hanging jerseys, washing all equipment weekly or every other week.
- If your team issued items (Jerseys, Practice Jerseys and Covers) are damaged, you will be invoiced for them when the season ends.
- Uniforms must be worn with pride and according to team standards.
- Equipment checks may be conducted to ensure safety and compliance.

11. Travel & Transportation

- All players must travel with the team unless prior arrangements are made. You must have the form from your school filled out ahead of time.
- Proper behavior is expected on buses and at all venues.
- We will clean our home locker room, our away locker room and we will clean the bus. The goal is to leave it better than when we walked in.
- Parents may be asked to assist with transportation for out-of-town games.

12. Communication Protocols

- The team will use Cross Bar, Text and Snap Chat for official communication.
- Please check regularly for updates on schedule changes and announcements.
- Use the 24-hour rule before discussing concerns with coaches (cool-down period after games and practices).
- If a player has an issue unrelated to playing time or position:
 - Approach the Captains First, if the issue is not solved
 - o Approach Assistant Coach(s), if the issue is not solved
 - Approach the Head Coach, if the issue is not solved
 - The head coach will involve the Athletic Directors and/or the Player can reach out to their School Athletic Director.
- If a player has an issue related to playing time or position:
 - o Approach Assistant Coach(s) First, if the issue is not solved
 - Approach the Head Coach, if the issue is not solved
 - The Head Coach will involve the Athletic Directors and/or the Player can reach out to their School Athletic Director.

13. Social Media Policy

- Players and Parents should think before posting.
- No negative comments about teammates, coaches, opponents, or officials.
- Sharing team photos or highlights is encouraged—but keep it respectful.
- Coaches reserve the right to address inappropriate social media behavior.

14. Emergency Procedures

- Coaches are trained in CPR/First Aid.
- Emergency contacts must be up to date.
- Injuries will be documented and reported to parents and school as necessary.
- Concussion protocol will be followed per WIAA rules.
