We are so excited to be looking to host our first Tournament this fall! To make this event successful, we need everyone's support and help!

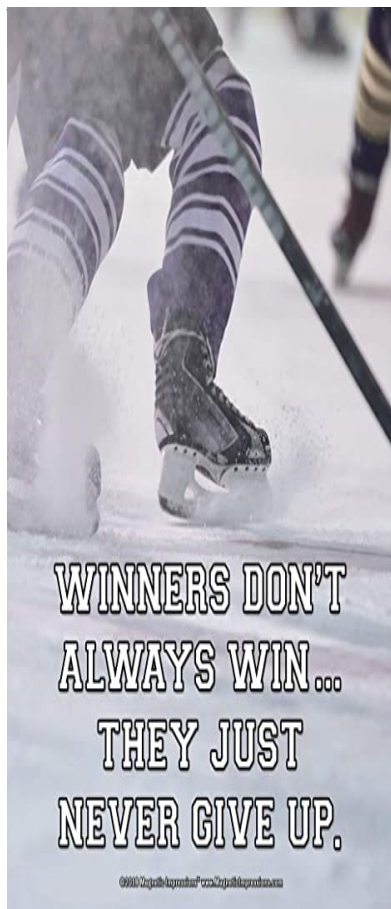
We are looking for full support of the association to make sure this event isn't just successful but something that we all look forward to each year to come!

ASSOCIATION FEES & DEADLINES

Registration is open now! If you register now you have the opportunity to split your fees into 5 monthly payments all ending by October 15th and receive this cool jacket (see section to the right for more details)!!

We are so lucky to have a team sport in our county that provides up to 24 weeks of ice time for the older teams and close to that for the younger ones. No other full team sport can boast a season that lasts as long. The skills that the players learn during that time frame being able to be with their same coaches and teammates is invaluable to so many areas of their overall development.

The Mites total fees for the year will be \$400. The Squirt & Pee wee fees total \$1350 that can be spread out over 5 months of payments. The Bantam fees are \$1250 that has a payment plan option as well.

Early bird registration ends on July 15th and the final date you can register your child for the Squirt level and up is by August 31st.

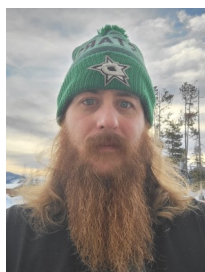
MEET THE DIRECTOR & BOARD

Maureen Bosshard -Vice President

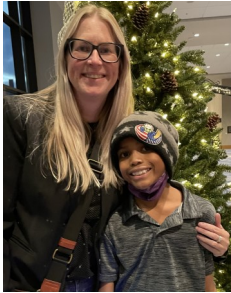
