- Current State of the Account: \$98,141.39 in operating cash
- o Concessions: \$4,903.83
- HS Program Donations
  - Currently giving \$500 per team (Boys + Girls program)
  - Would like to consider increasing donation to both programs given the current financial health of the association
  - Motion to increase the amount of donation to each HS team in the future to \$1,000. Made by < Z. Koering > and seconded by < J. Sawyer >. No opposed, no abstained, motion passed.

- Tournament Director Board Position
  - Nichole Cota is interested in the open position of Tournament Director
  - Motion made to appointment Nichole Cota as Tournament Director by < J. Hehir > and seconded by < S. Tourville >.

#### Old Business

- Gambling (Sam)
  - Account Balance: \$47,890.12
  - Gambling Donation: \$30,000
  - Gambling manager is now a voting member of the board (per the Gambling Commission's request)
  - SFYHA has to re-apply in 90 days for the gambling license
  - SFYHA should email to families before the season begins, highlighting gambling revenue and how the association is utilizing this money to support players and families
- Skill Training/Development (Jason/Vince)
  - SKATERS: Cal Miska provided a full training proposal support
    - Includes all travelling levels (boys and girls), as well as A mites, B mites, and 8U levels
    - 40 total ice sessions (5 groups x 8 sessions)
    - Motion for the Association to fund on-ice player skill and development training of Boys and Girls Traveling and A+B Mite and 8U programs with Cal Miska in the 2025/26 season – not to exceed \$13,400. Motion made by < J. Sawyer > and seconded by < S. Tourville >. No opposed, no abstained. Motion Carried.
  - GOALIES: SFYHA has 2 years remaining on 3-year agreement with MEGA
    - Motion for the Association to fund \$6,000 of goalie skill and development training of Boys and Girls
       Traveling and A/B Mite and 8U programs with MEGA in the 2025/26 season. Motion made by < A. Coy > at
       < 8:00PM > and seconded by < M. Wodziak >. No opposed, no abstained. Motion Carried.
- ALEC Leader Conference (Andy/Venessa)
  - Recap of Key Topics/Case Studies:
    - Hockey Think Tank parent culture investment is important and takes work and time
    - Growing Girls Hockey Hutchinson Pink Panther Mite Program girls-only Mite program, treating girls like its own club to build an inclusivity culture
    - Goaltending District 2 Net Size Pilot (intermediate nets in squirts) and goalie rotation switching goalies every 8 minutes
    - Tryout and Placement New placement method being tested by East Grand Forks and Detroit Lakes First
      months of season all players at a level practice together and then are placed on team. Evaluation of players
      is being done internally
  - USA Hockey is going through full software upgrade to track on coaching documentation
  - Continuing Ed credits for coaches

  - This Year's Preference:
    - Coach workshops: 90 minutes free (with SFYHA's PCA account)
      - Mastery Program
