- 6. **Tournaments Lindsay Stemig/Amanda Kuhn -** All Squirt teams Squirt A, B1,B2 & C made it into the Squirt International tournament in Fargo all hotel blocks for them have been secured.
- 7. Jerseys/Socks and Apparel- Jordan Webinger All upper level tryout- LL Tryout jerseys have arrived, working on mites and tiger cubs, Will have letterman samples @open house- Will have a apparel window open for Sept, Worked a deal to offer Hockey Yak
- 8. Facilities Scott Mack/Melissa Carey Update from Legacy Fund: The Feasibility Study has been completed, the architectural renderings and process is still ongoing. Ultimately a two sheet facility would become profitable in its second year of operation, losing approximately \$25,000 in year one due to start up costs. This was calculated using conservative numbers when it comes to ice usage and ice rental rates.

Scott and Melissa met with the City of Empire Park and Rec Commission on August 25th to share information about the partnership that FYHA and Community Hockey Legacy Fund have and the work we have been doing towards getting information needed to look into building a new facility. Their City Administrator shared how this aligns with their AUAR Study that the City Council is looking to approve in December with one of the potential models having a Sports Complex dedicated area in the plan. The commission was very excited

about the idea of potentially being able to have a community partnership if Empire pursued this next phase in their plan. The next step would be to continue discussions through the City Council.

Meetings have also been taking place with the school district. These conversations are in the early phase and just collecting information.
