## Quickbooks Update

Adjustments were made after reconciliation to get them their payment after Chase reversed the check, Quickbooks had to re-open that previous reconciliation.

- The summer skates budget was completed, information was posted on the website.

- o CSDHL
  - June 9th Major/Minors teams announced on the website
  - All teams are allowed in the prospects division
  - July 5th Major/Mino schedules will be out
  - July 20th Application process for prospects are due
  - August 9th Scheduling for Major/Minor
  - August 23rd Deadline for prospects / Aug 25th prospect teams will be placed, the 29th will be final placements based on team counts.
  - Sept 1st Scheduling for prospects (8 game preseason just like seeding but its being called preseason) this will be done via grid similar to CUHL
  - Sept 5 Oct 26 8 Games Start & End
  - Nov 1 Schedule & regular season play begins 20 games ending Jan 24th -Jan 29th Playoffs
  - Peoria rule will still be in effect for those teams that qualify
  - Playing time = Playing times for prospects will be 1 min less a period for every level except midget level
  - Refs= will be schedule by the league for illinois games only(4 man 18u, 3 man 16u, 2 man other levels)
  - Ice cuts= ice cuts for midget level will be half way through the 2nd period
  - Game sheets will be used for all age groups of play
  - Littleton, Colorado is out but the league will be talking to them, Hyland Hills Colorado midget level might be in prospects
  - Helmet stickers and patches will be passed out at the meeting in august/sept to the clubs
  - Scheduling will be done by email/text/calls/sign up genius
  - input rosters into Gamesheets immediately once a team has been formed
  - Trainers= mandatory for home games all midgets (can't be team emt, firefighter, mom nurse)
  - Parent conduct- 5 games automatic if parent is ejected
  - League can always raise the suspension separate from AHAI
  - 3 game suspension for fighting no exceptions, usa hockey and ahai is 1 game but the league is implementing 3 games.

- Will have all age groups Will have American (Lower) & National (higher)

- Pricing will most likely stay with what they were from last year.

  - Update to Fall 2025-2026 Rules
    - Period Lengths
      - o Mites/Squirts will remain at 11:00 Min Periods
      - o PeeWees will now play 12:00 Min Periods
      - o Bantams will remain at 13:00 Min Periods
      - o Midgets will now play 14 Min Periods
    - Period Lengths
      - NWHL will be adding 2 games to the Post-Tier schedule.
        Bridging a total to 20 games to the Fall Season before playoffs
    - Gold Division/Higher level of Play
      - O Have decided to add a "Friday Night Face Off" Plus league. This new league will be run by NWHL & will be combining with teams from the North Shore league to foster a more select/higher level of play. The idea of the league is that clubs can select "Plus" teams to play in the Friday Night League, 1 game a week so as not to interfere with the standard league play.
