 - Team final counts due 9/16 next board meeting
 - Board positions will be finalized VP & Treasurer
 - No more Spring league
 - One weekend for playoffs following weekend championship games
- o CUHL (Eric Scott)
 - Seeding round games have started 6 games
 - Regular season will have 9 home & 9 away
- o CS (Eric Scott)
 - Highland Hills and Iowa City are still in League, iowa city stated manager is working on scheduling games, The board was going to call Highland Hills to get them to schedule
 - There will be 14 midget scholarships available- information will be on the website in the upcoming weeks
 - The league stressed, THIS IS NOT NIHL, the board received numerous calls about scheduling and times, there is no time restriction for game starts like NIHL, just stressed be reasonable
 - \$1,000 bond on all teams, will see this on the league bill when sent out
 - 2026-2027 League Fees- \$1,700 for Major/Minor and red division teams,
 \$1,500 for White and Blue divisions
 - Players moving up need the CS board approval
 - Parent ejection- 5 games (same as our club policy)
 - Suspensions must satisfy the USA hockey requirement plus Central States Requirement.

- Do not change the team names in GameSheets, this will mess up the schedule and it will not upload, please leave it how it has been entered by the league
- Game time changes: Email Greg Agrest the new date, time and location.
 Also include the gamessheet game number, this makes it easier to find it, change it and for ref assignment.
- The ref site is not up for new viewers yet, league will have access to it soon, once league has access it should be available to the ref schedulers soon
- Do not email the league if stats are wrong on Games Sheets
- No coaches in the handshake lines
- Home team supplies warm up pucks for visiting teams
- Ice cuts for midgets in the middle of the 2nd period, then center ice faceoff
- Trainers required for all Midgets
- Overtime- 3v3 5 minutes, if tied after 5 minutes, game is over
- No forfeits in Central States
- CS will be have 2 CS game of the weeks, teams will be notified
- Social Media, follow CS on FB and Instagram, tag CS and they will also publish fun things, team parties, team bonding, etc
- Looking for ice donations for playoffs, the league will pay for it
- Playoffs, the goal is for every division to have playoffs, no cross divisions
- 250 teams total in CS for 2025 season
- Invoices will be sent out oct/nov, emailed to the reps and presidents. Zell, check, no venmo or credit cards
- Looking at Major/Minor doing electronic scheduling for next year
- Attendee from Leafs asked if grids can be released at noon next scheduling cause their hockey director was at a tournament, majority of the attendance disagreed and said 4pm was reasonable due to people working, the board agreed

Collectively it was decided the person in violation has been docked hours from their work total as of Sept 15th, and I will be speaking with the individual personally at their athletes next practice.
- o Parent Participation
 - Ensuring parents are actively signing up and feel comfortable in the role they are required to do (clock sign up), Leading into the start of the season are we seeing active sign ups for the participation and what does that look like.
 - Since we have no opt out (pay out option), what is discouraging parents to not sign up and just assess the \$350.00 at the end of the season? It's simply acting in the same fashion if there was an opt out option.

- I had a parent pull me aside this past Friday, she is new to the club and travel, but shared some concern on the lack of coaching presence at their practices. Simply stating there has only been one coach present for a large number of practices and she feels her team is neglected and not given the same level of attention as the higher teams are. Not an R&E issue nor is it a board issue, but an example on how simple communication to the team could provide clarity and avoid bad feeling from developing, ultimately affecting the dynamic of a team's culture.
- Ultimately communication no matter how big or small can midgate larger issues from evolving. Some of these issues or things that come up through a season are understood or known by more seasoned club members, but not everyone is operating at the same level.
