# **Daktronics 4000 Series Control Console Operational Instructions**

## **BEFORE THE GAME**



- **POWER OFF/ON** located on the back of the unit
- 1. Press **Off**, then **On** to start the Power On Sequence

### POWER ON SEQUENCE FOR GAME MODE





## **GAME TIME**

Use the **START** and **STOP** buttons **OR** the toggle button on the **REMOTE** to start and stop the clock.

### Set Period Time (and warm-up time)

- Press SET MAIN CLOCK, type in period time, press ENTER (it will default to previous period time)
  Set Period
- 1. To ADVANCE the period, press PERIOD+1
- To SET or CORRECT the Period, press Period then enter the Period # on the number pad,

press **ENTER**.



#### **Enter Score**

- 1. To ADVANCE the score, press SCORE+1 for HOME or GUEST
- To SET or CORRECT the score, press SCORE for HOME or GUEST



#### **Enter Penalty**

1. Press PLAYER PENALTY for HOME or GUEST





SCORE

2. **LCD displays** which player you are setting the time for (1 PL, 2 PL, etc...)



3. Press ENTER, ENTER, ENTER (penalty will default to 2:00 minutes. If you need to enter a 5 minute penalty, press ENTER, ENTER, type in 500, ENTER)

## **GAME TIME - continued**

### **Clear Penalty OR Correct Penalty**

1. Press PLAYER PENALTY for HOME or GUEST



2. **LCD displays** which player penalty you are currently viewing (1 PL, 2 PL, etc...)



3. Press or to find the correct Player Penalty on the LCD display you want to clear, then press CLEAR, ENTER.



# AFTER THE GAME

If there's another game scheduled, run through the **BEFORE THE GAME** steps so the clock is set and ready for the next game

If there is NO GAME scheduled, go through the steps below to set up the time of day:

### Set Up Clock for Time of Day

- 1. Turn the **toggle On/Off switch** on the back left of the Control Console to **Off**, then **On** to start the **Power On Sequence**
- 2. Press Clear/No button to the prompt "RESUME GAME?"
- 3. Enter **099** on the number pad, then **ENTER**
- 4. Press the SET MAIN CLOCK button in response to the prompt "ENTER COMMAND".
- Type in time and press ENTER (the Time of Day should now appear on the Scoreboard) Revised 6-3-21
