Agenda/New Business

Finances overview [Blane]:

- Items to purchase for ADM
- - (2) mite net Shooter Tutors [\$299.95 ea]---Blane to buy
- look at options to replace some of the beat up black pads to divide the ice. Do we need to find a different/ cheaper option?
 - Looking like (4) teams again in the CUHL
 - Rosters will be 12 to 13 kids plus goalie
 - 56ish total kids in the mite program
 - I would like to use some of our free ice from USA hockey to schedule a "Skate with Coach Sean" ... our Top Mite teams hockey coach!! Sean can then have our other mite coaching staff on the ice to run some skills stations / powerskating and promote the 8U Mite program.

<u>CSDHL</u>

- Applications will be sent out by July 20th to clubs that completed the initial google sheet. Applications are due by August 23rd. Prospect division levels will be announced on September 1.
- League fees are \$1500 per team [this is \$200 more per team than NIHL cost last season].
- Scheduling grids will be released September 9th and November 1st.

<u>NWHL</u>

• No information has been sent out yet [per Wendy Bussie]. NH will continue to monitor emails and the NWHL website for any league updates.

Midwest Superior Girls Hockey League (NIHL) / Girls Teams

- Girls tryouts are completed. St. Jude will have 3 teams (14U, 16U, 19U) entered at National level.
- Season scheduling for these teams will be July 24-27 [will be completed online]
- League fees for 2025-2026: \$500 organization fee + \$800/team fee = \$2900
- Summer skill skates registration is open to girls @ 12U 19U levels. Two slots being offered: 12U/14U and 16U/19U. Both slots are on Tuesdays July 8th August 26th.

CUHL [Meg]

- Scheduling will be done by Jen & Randi.
- Changes on the import rule: Now, any kid can come to any team if that player has never played for a CUHL team before. So for example, a kid that does learn to skate/play at Arctic can still come to play for us and there are no number restrictions to how many can come here. If a player has played for a CUHL team, then it is still the 2 import rule per team. For example, a kid played for Vikings mite 1 but now wants to come to St. Jude for mite 2, he can as long as there are no more than 2 other players from the same club on that team.
- Try goalie for free clinic on July 27th at Artic that is being run through AHAI.
- The officials will run like AHAI in a system. CUHL league will still do all the assignments.
- Fees are \$250 per team and \$1300 for officials for a total of \$1550 per team. Team counts are due by Aug 1st with payments. August 15th is when we can register for AAU. Final team declarations and payments are due August 27th. Seeding starts Sept 12th. Will be the same grid scheduling as last year. October 31st starts the regular season.
