Please be aware that Manitowoc County Youth Hockey strictly follows the WAHA Zero Tolerance Policy.

This policy can be found on the WAHA website under the Guide Book tab.

The following are NOT allowed at any time:

- 1. Any use or sale of drugs, alcohol or tobacco products during the hockey season.
- 2. Any use of a stick or skate with intent to harm or injure another player or person.
- 3. Any fighting or horseplay that could result in bodily injury or property damage.
- 4. Any taunting of other players or spectators at any time.
- 5. Any disrespect, such as name calling or talking back, to coaches or officials.
- 6. Any use of vulgar or obscene language or gestures, even if is not directed at a particular person.
- 7. Any playing of music that contains explicit profanity.
- 8. Any act of vandalism or theft at any Ice Center.

I understand that hockey is a team sport and that it is necessary that I get along with my teammates. This means that I should encourage my teammates rather than criticize them. I will work hard to improve my skills, be on time for practices and games and play by the rules. I will treat opponents and officials with respect both in victory and defeat.

I pledge to follow the rules outlined above and understand that disciplinary action may be taken against me by my coach and/or the Hockey Association for breaking any of these rules.
