all single letters (b, f, o, t, x, u) represent a tournament. To you there is no difference. Y is the only exception. It refers to season length, not a tournament  
 "sub" means this is a weekend you may want to keep open to play on another team or if your team fills in for a dropped team  
 "add" in an event that with approval could be a parent-driven add-on. As a rough rule of thumb see below for add on costs  
 "add" is an optional add-on Dec ~ \$25/player, other single days ~\$35/player, 2-day events ~ \$110/player, Qualifiers ~ \$200/player  
 "rep" & "or" are usually for other tournaments that can replace one of your current tournaments. Rep is usually a parent driven option and "or" is club driven  
 "NTC" "no" "con" "see" & "can" are NOT tournaments for that particular team  
 "zero" denotes zero practices for that week

\* zero" denotes zero practices for that week

\* "pos" is a possible tournament that could be added;
