- Fundraising target for 25-26 Season: previous year's amount for fundraising ~\$25k not including sponsorships.



Notes/Discussion:

Follow-up email from last meeting - reached out to SF about the possibility of combining numbers at the Bantam Level. They advised that they would be willing to accept waived players, but are not interested in co-op at a single level.

Email thread discussing the projected numbers for the Bantam and Peewee hockey teams for the 2025-2026 season and a proposal from Saint Francis to waive North Branch's entire Bantam team to them.

Vote Needed:

Vote A: waive the entire bantam team to St Francis.

Vote B: stay the course and if a player or two drops try to find a player or two from other associations, if not we will need to get creative within our own association.

Key points include:

- Player projections shared, indicating that if all current players stay, the Bantam team would be short only one player compared to last season, and the Peewee team would have the same number of players.
- Points brought forward against waiving the entire Bantam team due to potential revenue loss, disruption to ice time, fear of players quitting, and concern for player development. It was also noted that the District 10 Director will likely not allow an entire team to be waived.
- Several board members voted to "stay the course" (Option B), which involves trying to find players from other associations if numbers drop.
- One Member expressed discomfort voting without speaking to the affected families first and plans to reach out to them for more solid numbers.
- One Member disagreed with waiving the entire team, citing past injuries and the potential
 for a small team to be in trouble if players are out. It was also asked if it was discussed to
 have one association level at B1 and the other at B2, and about reaching out to players
 with late summer birthdays who might play Bantam another year.

Summary:

Email thread discussing the preliminary design study for a childcare and arena plan in North Branch, with a focus on where to locate the childcare facility to secure a \$500,000 grant.

President initiated the discussion, presenting a concept plan for the childcare space on the main floor and requesting a vote by tomorrow at 5 PM on whether to place the daycare on the main level (option 1) or the second floor (option 2). He emphasized the urgency to avoid losing the grant and having to pay for the design study out of pocket.

Vote was requested for these two options:

#1 - Ok for the day care to be on the main level per the plan

#2 - Daycare on the 2nd floor

Several board members weighed in with their opinions. The general consensus leans towards placing the childcare on the first floor due to easier access, safety, and cost-effectiveness.

Concerns were raised regarding the loss of storage space if the daycare moved to the first floor, but it was clarified that the conference room would move upstairs (to a 750 sq ft space previously intended for storage), and alternative storage for mite equipment would be found. The importance of the grant for the overall arena project and the need to be flexible with usage were also highlighted.
