Locker Room



- The locker room will open 30 minutes before practice starts
- Skaters may not be in the locker room without Coach or designated locker room monitor who has SafeSport certification/ background check and cleared WYH
- No Cell Phones in Locker Room
- No Photo taking in locker room
- PeeWees dress and tie skates without adult help. By the end of the season, Squirts should be able to the same. Work on this throughout the season

Appropriate Behavior



- Wausau Youth Hockey has historically done really well with good behavior.
 - There are other associations that aren't.
- Wausau Youth Hockey expects appropriate parent behavior
- Have a concern - contact your level coordinator, manager or coach.

Concession Stand



- WYH must staff the concession stand in order to fulfill our contract with the County.
- No selling in Concession stand = No ice rental

Few Reminders:

- Do not dump grease down the sink drain
- Workers must be 16 + to be in the concession stand when open and preparing food.
- Two people must count money and sign deposit slip
- If something is out of stock, write in notebook and we will get it ordered ASAP.
- Must practice good hygiene, wash hands, keep food at proper temperature, and label all leftovers with current date

Dibs



- Must have 1/2 dibs signed up (not completed) by November 10
- All dibs signed up by January 10, 2024
- If not completed, your skater will not be able to play in games
- Reminder: sign up for dibs on wausauhockey.org, must be signed into your account.

Practice



- Practice with another team.
 - Typically the same 2 teams will practice on the same sheet all season
- Monday night Power Skate and Skills & Drills and bimonthly goalie clinics.
 - Monday nights - check your crossbar schedule



Typical “Extra” Costs for the Season

- Raffle basket for the Ice Breaker banquet and home tournament (think about donations)
- Coach and manager gifts at the end of the season
- Team pictures
- Lodging + related expenses at away tournament
- May be other costs depending on team

- Parent help needed - clock, Game Sheet, penalty box, raffle table, sucker pull
 - This is separate from Dibs
- Food / Dish to share
- Donations needed
 - Goody bags
 - Sucker pull
 - Raffle basket

- Likely will require a hotel stay
- Hotel blocks have been set by Team Manager Coordinator.
 - Ask your manager for information
