

SCOREKEEPER INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for volunteering to maintain the score sheet for today's game. Please write clearly so the person receiving the sheets at Missouri Hockey can read it. To help make you more comfortable with your responsibilities, please use the following as a guide.

BEFORE THE GAME:

- Obtain 3-part score sheet from the home team manager.
- Write the team names are written in space provided at top of form as well as the date of the game, rink played at, game type circled, and division and level circled (Section **A**).
- Check score sheet to be sure that rosters are printed/labeled for both teams on all three pages (Section **B**).
- Get each head coach to sign the roster (Section **B**).

DURING THE GAME:

- Write down the time the game started (Section **C**).
- For each goal that is scored, go to the HOME/VISITOR SCORING section of the sheet (Section **D**). Record goal type (Type), period (Per), time left in period (Time), and jersey number(s) of the player awarded the goal (G) and player(s) awarded assists (A). The referee will give you this information. Total each goals at the end of each period (Section **E**).
- Goal Types
 - EV = Even Strength PP = Power Play SH = Shorthanded
 - EN = Empty Net EA = Extra Attacker PS = Penalty Shot
- For each penalty, go to the HOME TEAM/VISITING TEAM PENALTIES section of the sheet (Section **F**). Record period (PER), jersey number (NO) of penalized player, type of offense/infraction (OFFENSE), length of penalty (MIN) (usually 1:30), time left in the period (Off), when the penalty started (Start) (usually the same time as time left in period, unless more than two penalties are being served at once) and when the player returns to the ice (On).
- **If you want** to record Shots On Goal (SOG), keep track of them by using hash marks in the appropriate column (Section **G**) during each period. A SOG is any shot that enters or would enter the net if not blocked by the goalie (hitting the post is NOT a SOG). At the end of each period, record Shots on Goal for each team.

AFTER THE GAME:

- Write down the time the game ended (Section **H**).
- Total up goals and record it in the TOTAL column in the SCORING BY PERIODS section, and total up shots on goal for each team in the SHOTS ON GOAL section (Section **I**). Also record the final score in the final score section of the sheet (Section **J**).
- Cross out any rows in section **D** and **F** that were not filled out.
- Write your name in the space provided as OFFICIAL SCORER. Give the score sheet to ALL referees for them to review and sign (Section **K**).
- Give the completed score sheet back to team manager.
