I AGREE TO:

☑ BE A POSITIVE ROLE MODEL

I will lead by example, showing respect toward all players, coaches, officials, and families—regardless of the outcome of the game.

▼ SUPPORT MY CHILD'S COMMITMENT

I will help ensure my child attends practices and games, is prepared and on time, and upholds their responsibilities to their team.

▼ RESPECT COACHES AND OFFICIALS

I will let coaches coach and referees officiate. I will not interfere with gameplay, question calls, or criticize staff or volunteers from the stands or sidelines.

☑ CELEBRATE EFFORT, NOT JUST RESULTS

I will focus on effort, improvement, and enjoyment—not just wins and losses. I understand that growth comes from participation and learning.

▼ COMMUNICATE RESPECTFULLY

I will bring concerns to the appropriate person (coach, HOC, or board member) in a respectful and appropriate manner, away from the rink and never during games or practices.

▼ FOSTER A SAFE, INCLUSIVE ENVIRONMENT

I will support a zero-tolerance policy for bullying, harassment, or discrimination. I will promote a welcoming, supportive culture for all players and families.
