



AHA Board of Directors Meeting Minutes

September 16th, 2025

- 1) Call to Order/Determination of Quorum (Witte)
 - a. Meeting called to order at 7:06 pm. Members present: Duke Witte, Derek Hadrick, Katie Linke, Laura Edwards, Mike Schmit, Tony Mulder, Scott Oswald, Garrett Wobst, Mark Gederos. No guests.
- 2) Open Forum Discussion (Witte)
 - a. none
- 3) Presentation and Adoption of the Agenda (Witte)
 - a. Motion by Linke, second by Wobst. Motion passes.
- 4) Presentation and Approval of Last Month's Board Meeting Minutes (Edwards)
 - a. Motion by Hadrick, second by Linke. Motion passes.
- 5) HDC Facilitation Update (Witte/Linke)
 - a. Katie met with all coordinators of Squirt to Varsity. 8U will be on Sep 17.
 - b. Master Coordinator will be Carrie Weisenburger for Squirt and up levels.
 - c. Rental equipment has all been received. Community Foundation money has been received. The Foundation is planning for Sep 29th at noon for a photo at the rink.
 - d. Elliott Gall is scheduler. There is a calendar widget on the website to see all activities on the ice under "Facility". App will only show your team schedule.
 - e. DIBS need to be accessed through the website, not the app.
 - f. All new jerseys are completed and will be delivered this week. Invoices sent out today for jerseys.
 - g. Growth Coordinator position has been sitting vacant. Amber Schwab has agreed to serve. Will take on social media and links to the website. USA Hockey has guidance on this role.
- 6) Hockey Operations Update (Schmidt), given by Witte.
 - a. All head coaches confirmed except 8U. Working to identify practice schedules.
 - b. G14U/BAN/JV/V start practices Oct 11. Lower levels will gradually be added to the schedule with later start dates.

- c. Thinking of 6U & 8U first year players Learn to Skate sessions and then phase into Learn to Play. Jeremy Wasem will lead. Jeremy is working with David Mitchell.
- 7) Rink Committee Update (Urlacher)
 - a. Sunday, Sep 14–CO2 pipe broke on compressor, some oil leaked also. Repairs were under warranty and will be replaced.
 - b. AHA takes possession of Expo on Oct 1. Ice will be set mid-month.
 - c. Still trying to get estimates on fire alarm system.
- 8) Acceptance of Financial Reports (Linke)
 - a. Monthly Transactions
 - b. Profit & Loss / Budget vs. Actuals

 - d. Katie will move old invoices from SportsEngine to Crossbar.
 - e. QQP coordinates sponsorship of program book and ads. We get about \$10k from the sponsorship plus cost of printing is covered.
 - f. The County has requested an adjustment to our agreement for the Expo, now asking for a percentage of the ice fees paid by Curling club to be returned to the County.
 - Motion by Schmit to approve 33% of curling rental revenue to go to County.
 Encourage getting written agreement/addendum to our lease to include this fee.
 Second by Edwards. Motion does not pass.
 - ii. Board members will ask for more time to consider this request while they gather more information.
 - g. Motion to accept treasurer's report by Gederos, second by Wobst. Motion passes.
- 9) Concessions Operation (Witte)
 - a. Linke family has presented a proposal for a 5-year contract to operate the concession stand. Email voting passed 4-3 in favor. Witte will finalize contract with Linke family.
- 10) Tickets for Cleaning staff at Wings Games (Witte)
 - a. Snow Queens are continuing cleaning. Wings will not pay for admission tickets for cleaning crew.
- 11) AHA Discipline Update (Hadrick)
 - a. none
- 12) Update from SDAHA/USA Hockey Meetings (Witte)
 - a. Witte attended the Northern Plains district meeting in Deadwood. Focus on growth of numbers of players (especially girls), player development, SafeSport.

- b. Witte attended the State League meeting.
 - i. Some requests to play down were approved. Brandon Valley & Sioux Center will move Bantam A down to Bantam B.
 - ii. Boys Varsity will have 22 game season, 12 teams. Sioux Falls will host state tournament.
 - iii. Boys JV will have 13 team, 24 games. Watertown will host state tournament.
 - iv. Girls Varsity will have 21 games, Mitchell will host state tournament.
 - v. 6 teams are fielded for Girls JV, no state tournament.
 - vi. Girls 14U state tournament will be hosted by Oahe.
 - vii. Bantam A will play 18 game season. Yankton will host state tournament.
 - viii. Bantam B will field 8 teams, 14-21 games. 2 teams not eligible (play down for Brandon and Sioux Center). Aberdeen will host 6 team tournament.
 - ix. PWA will field 8 teams with 18 games. Brookings will host state tournament.
 - x. PWB will field 8 teams with 18 games. Huron will host state tournament.
 - xi. PWC will field 6 teams with 14-16 games. Rapid City will host state tournament.
 - xii. SqA 8 teams. SqB 10 teams. SqC 9 teams. ABR will field SqA and SqC teams. All Squirt levels will play 16 games and additional jamborees.
 - xiii. Rebrand SDAHA? Committee assembled to help with this. Asking for help in social media, news releases around the state.
